Follett Destiny



1. Go to <https://destinydiscover.com>
2. Select Ohio and your school from the menu
3. Login to your school's catalog with the following information  
Username: Student ID number  
Password: Student birthday (Format: mm-dd-yyyy)
4. Once logged in, search using keywords: ebooks or audiobooks
5. Click on the selected title to begin

\*If the item you select directs you to [www.MackinVIA.com](http://www.MackinVIA.com) log in with the following information for your school's generic account:  
Username: ccs(schoolname) Example: ccsbriggs  
Password: ccs

1. Go to <https://ck.overdrive.com/ck-columbus/teens>
2. Sign in with your Library Card
3. Search for title/author/subject
4. Selected titles appear under My Account>Loans

Project Gutenberg



1. Go to <http://www.gutenberg.org/> and search the title you want
2. Choose title, and read online OR download to your Dropbox, Google Drive, or MS Cloud account
3. Make sure you have the entire version of the book  
-offers more than 46,000 free ebooks: choose among free epub books, free Kindle books, download them or read them online

LibriVox



1. Go to <https://librivox.org/> & search by author, title, subject, etc.
2. Multiple versions of your book may show up--make sure you select the version with the entire book
3. Listen online or download using green buttons on left side of screen  
-offers free public domain audiobooks read by volunteers
