**Job Definition:** Under direction is responsible for making skilled repairs to gasoline and diesel powered school buses, landscaping equipment and other automotive and heavy duty type equipment; performs related tasks as required.

**Required General Experience and Training (at time of filing application):**

Any combination of training and experience equivalent to completion of the twelfth school grade and four years experience as an automotive mechanic, one year of which must have been at the journey level. Possession of a valid Ohio motor vehicle operator's license with a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) temporary permit. A Commercial Driver's License with class A endorsement must be obtained with 90 days after appointment. Training for the Commercial Driver's License will be provided at the Board of Education's expense. Note: An official transcript, Certificate of Completion, or diploma must be presented, in order to receive credit for any post high school or vocational training (education). It is the responsibility of the applicant to list all relevant work experience on his/her application.
