Arts Impact		<p><b>BOTTOMS:</b> Solid black business casual or uniform pants, skirts, or shorts. Must be sized to fit at the waist, shorts and skirts must be knee length. Girls may also wear Capri pants in the same color. <b>NO DENIM.</b></p> <p><b>TOPS:</b> White polo shirt (no prints or designs) short or long sleeved, sized to fit. During colder weather students may wear a solid Black or White sweater over collared shirts.</p> <p><b><i>At no time will students be permitted to wear any kind of jackets, sweatshirts, and hoodies (even attached to sweaters/shirts) in the classroom. No sleeveless shirts or tank tops, no T-shirts.</i></b></p> <p><b>SHOES:</b> Students should wear comfortable shoes. No flip flops, shower shoes, house slippers or sandals.</p>
Berwick K-8		<p>Navy bottoms <b>ONLY</b> and white, light yellow, light blue polos. No khaki colored bottoms. All layers/socks must be in uniform colors. No hooded sweaters. No sweatshirts or hooded sweatshirts.</p>
Buckeye	XXX	<p>It is expected that the attire of Buckeye students will be neat, clean, and appropriate for school. No apparel should distract from a student's learning or keep them from being productive members of the Buckeye community. This is in accordance with the CCS District policy.</p>
Champion		<p><b>BOYS:</b> SHIRTS - white, black or orange shirt. Short or long-sleeved permitted. <b>BLACK</b> or white polo shirt. <b>MUST</b> have standard collar. No logo unless it is the Champion Middle School logo. Solid black or solid white T-shirt worn underneath only.</p> <p><b>PANTS:</b> Khaki pants only. <b>SHOES:</b> White or black tennis shoes. Belts are required.</p> <p><b>GIRLS:</b> SHIRTS - White blouses with collar or polo shirts: white, black or orange shirt. Short or long-sleeved permitted. Black or white polo shirt. <b>MUST</b> have standard collar. No logo unless it is the Champion Middle School logo. Solid black or solid white T-shirt maybe worn underneath the required white shirt with a standard collar; Solid black or solid white pullover sweater must be worn, this may be a crew neck, V-neck or sweater vest; Solid black or solid white cardigan sweater; Long-sleeved black or white turtleneck; <b>ANY</b> Champion T-shirts with logo.</p>
CC Prep Boys		<p>Long or short sleeve Oxford cloth shirt w/ school logo, tie, black pants w/ belt and shirt tucked inside pants, black shoes, black sweater vest w/ school logo (Worn during late fall and winter). Casual Uniform Options - Black or white long/short sleeve knit polo shirt w/ school logo, black knee length walking shorts w/ belts and shirt tucked inside shorts, black or white tennis shoes.</p>
CC Prep Girls		<p>Mandatory Official Uniform - pink Oxford button-up blouse with school logo (short/long sleeve), black vest with school logo, black &amp; white checkered cross tie, black &amp; white checkered skirt, black or white solid tights or knee socks, 100% black or brown shoes (no sneakers). Casual Uniform Options - pink polo shirt (short/long sleeve) with school logo, black full length slacks, black Bermuda shorts, black skirt, and plain, solid black belt with plain buckle.</p>

Medina	XXX	District dress code policy - NO SOLID RED and NO SOLID BLUE T-shirts are to be worn at any time. In addition, students are NOT PERMITTED to wear tank tops, sandals or flip flops.
Mifflin Middle		<p><b>BOYS:</b> Baby blue, navy, or white collared shirt. The shirts may either be a polo or Oxford style either long or short sleeved. Khaki or black pants with a belt. During the months of August through October, boys may wear walking shorts in either Khaki or black with a belt. During the colder months, students will be permitted to wear either a navy or white sweater or sweater vest.</p> <p><b>GIRLS:</b> Baby blue, navy, or white collared shirt. The shirts may either be polo or Oxford style either long or short sleeved. Girls will also be required to wear Khaki or black pants or skirts. The skirt length must be knee length. During the months of August through October, girls may wear walking shorts in either Khaki or black. During the colder months, students will be permitted to wear either a navy or white sweater.</p> <p><b>No students will be permitted to wear jeans, sweatpants, hooded sweatshirts, or leggings. Students will also not be permitted to wear outerwear jackets during the school day. This includes jogging suit jackets and sport jackets.</b></p>

Sherwood		<p>Sherwood Middle School is a uniform dress code school. Students are expected to be in full uniform each day. Our uniform is listed below:</p> <p><b>Shirts</b>-Shirts must be collared, appropriately sized, worn tucked in, and a solid color. Approved colors are white, navy blue or black. Solid colored sweaters / crew neck sweatshirts may be worn in cooler weather. Sherwood spirit shirts are also permitted. Hooded sweatshirts and sleeveless shirts <b>are not permitted</b>.</p> <p><b>Pants/Slacks</b> -Pants must be appropriately sized and worn with a belt (if there are belt loops on the pants). Solid colors of black, navy blue, or khaki are permitted. Blue Jeans, leggings worn as pants, hot pants, sweatpants, carpenter pants, athletic pants, etc. are not permitted. Sagging is not allowed in school.</p> <p><b>Knee-Length Skirts</b> - Skirts must not be shorter than mid-thigh. Solid colors of black, navy blue, or khaki are permitted. In cooler weather, tights/leggings may be worn under skirts that are not shorter than mid-thigh. Jeans skirts are not permitted.</p> <p><b>Capris &amp; Shorts</b> - Walking shorts (boys) and knee-length walking shorts/ capris (girls) are to be knee length in solid colors of black, navy blue, or khaki and are permitted during warmer weather months. Shorts, knee-length walking shorts &amp; capris may not be worn from November through spring break.</p> <p><b>Shoes/Boots</b> -Shoes must be closed toe and attached at the heel. Rubber soled shoes are preferred. High heeled shoes/boots are not permitted. Heels should be 1 inch or less.</p> <p><b>Personal Hygiene</b> - Students are expected to take care of their personal hygiene needs in an appropriate manner at home. The spraying of Axe, perfumes, etc. is not appropriate in the halls or classrooms. If needed, the nurse can assist with hygiene emergencies during the school day.</p> <p>Clothing may not be tight or form-fitting. Clothing may not be see-through. Outdoor apparel is not to be worn in the classrooms. This includes hats, gloves, scarves, coats, jackets, and sunglasses, etc.</p>

Yorktown		<p>Students must abide by the dress code established by Columbus City Schools. Additional Requirements Specific to Yorktown:</p> <p>Solid Red, Blue, White, Black or Orange undershirts/t-shirts are NOT PERMITTED. Layering of these colors is also not permitted. Shirts 3" or more below the waist must remain tucked in.</p> <p>For shorts, dresses, or skirts, Yorktown staff shall define mid-thigh as being no higher than 3" above the knee. All pants/shorts/skirts are to be worn at the natural waistline. Sagging will not be permitted. NO GYM SHORTS.</p> <p>A neat, school-appropriate appearance is expected at all times. Any form of dress, article of clothing, jewelry, or accessory that takes away from or may cause a distraction to the educational environment at Yorktown may be restricted.</p> <p>School administration reserves the right to revise and further restrict articles of clothing, as necessary.</p> <p>Absolutely Not Permitted</p> <p>Solid Black Hoodies, Red Belts, Blue Belts, Shorts Higher Than 3" Above the Knee, House Shoes/Slippers, Elastic Gym/Athletic Shorts, Blankets, Hats, Bandanas, Head Scarves, Shoes With Heels Higher Than 1" (no stilettos), Pajama Pants, Tank Tops, (Boys No Sleeveless Shirts), Spaghetti Strap Shirts, Low Cut Shirts That Expose Any Cleavage or That Hang Off of the Shoulder, Tunics/Shirts Worn With Leggings Must Not Be Shorter Than 3" Above the Knee, Sagging, Any Clothing That is Inappropriately Revealing or See-Through, Sunglasses, Pants/Shorts/Sweatpants With Writing Across the Seat, No Rips, Tears or Cuts in ANY clothing including Pants, Shirts, Jackets, or Shorts.</p>
