Dominion	The dress code is a primary means of helping students and families
	understand that there are requirements related to dress in the business
	world for success in securing and maintaining employment. On August 16,
	2005 the Columbus Board of Education approved two policies that, when
	implemented, will help to ensure a positive climate for learning in all our
	schools. The purpose of the Dominion dress code is to provide guidance to
	students and parents regarding appropriate attire for school and at any
	school functions. The first district wide policy expects all students to adhere
	to a code of decent dress for school. Students are not to wear clothing
	that could compromise their personal safety or the safety of others.
	Specific provisions include:
	Undergarments must be concealed at all times.
	Clothing should be "business world" appropriate: (No bare midriffs
	or see-through clothing, private areas appropriately kept private,
	no night or sleeping clothes; and no underwear as outerwear
	RIP (rest in peace) shirts may be an emotional trigger for another
	student, so shouldn't be worn to school.
	 Head covering worn in the building should serve a religious
	purpose. Sunglasses may not be worn inside.
	 Pants must be worn at the waist. No excessively saggy pants or
	excessively short shorts. Long pants must be of proper waist size
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	and must not hang below the waist, with pants not touching or
	dragging on the ground;

	 Belts must fit properly and not be more than three inches longer than the student's measured waist size; Clothing and jewelry shall be free of writing, pictures, or any other insignia which are crude, vulgar, profane, sexually suggestive, or which advocate negative racial, ethnic, gender or religious prejudice, or use or glorification of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, or violence. Dress should not be disruptive. Purses, fanny packs and book bags will be kept locked in student lockers. Appropriate footwear include shoes that cover the heel. House slippers and "flip flop", pool shoes or athletic sandals aren't appropriate for school. The principal has discretion over the dress code.

for pants/shorts to remain at the waist.
• Tops must be worn at all times and must be sized appropriately.
Undershirts may not be worn as outerwear, may not be low cut; see
through, off the shoulder or otherwise revealing. Tube tops,
spaghetti strap tops, tank tops, halter tops and/or any strapless top
or dress are not permitted. No bare midriffs permitted. As a test for
appropriate length, student bodies shall not be exposed when arms
are raised above their heads.
• Shoes must be worn at all times and should protect the feet from
injury. Flip-flops, slippers/bedroom shoes and beach shoes are not
permitted. Rubber soles are recommended.
 Hats, slumber bonnets, "do-rags", caps and other types of head
covering (other than for religious purposes) and Outerwear shall
not be worn inside the building. Hoodies may not be worn over the
head inside the building. Hair rollers may not be worn inside the
building.
 Accessories and hair color are to be decent and appropriate for
school. Accessories may not be oversized, noisy, gaudy or otherwise
distracting. Chains and spikes are not permitted.
Backpacks/backpack purses, knapsacks, fanny packs, oversized
purses, sunglasses, gloves, scarves, headphones/earbuds,
earmuffs, etc. may not be worn inside the school. Belts are to be no
longer than 3" larger than the student's correctly measured
waistline. Any accessory that may be considered a distraction or
danger will be restricted.
Gang Symbols and Gang-Related Apparel shall be defined as
apparel that, if worn or displayed, could be determined or affiliate
the student as a part of a gang and/or threaten the health and
safety of the student or school environment. The administration
may prohibit the presence of any apparel, jewelry, accessory or
manner of grooming which, by virtue of its color, arrangement,
trademark, or any other attribute denotes membership in such a
group.(i.e., wearing or possession of chains, rags, bandannas,
stocking caps, long belts, baggy/oversized pants, cutoff or saggy
pants, pants worn very low below the waist, fronts, etc.) Any student
wearing or carrying overt gang paraphernalia or making gestures
that symbolize gang membership shall be referred to the building
principal or assistant principal.
In cases of dress code violations and questionable dress (not explicitly
covered in these guidelines) the student will be counseled by a teacher,

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	counselor, or administrator and appropriate corrective and/or disciplinary action taken, including, when necessary, a home contact seeking parental cooperation and assistance. Students will also be requested to change into appropriate clothing or be issued alternative clothing (i.e. a school t- shirt), if necessary. Repeat infractions will result in appropriate discipline. Students are responsible for adhering to all dress code policies contained within the CCS Guide to Student Success and those outlined in the Ridgeview Middle School Student Handbook.
Sherwood	 Shirts must be collared, appropriately sized, and a solid color of black, navy blue, or white. Solid colored sweaters/crew neck sweatshirts may be worn in cooler weather. Sherwood spirit shirts are also permitted. Hooded sweatshirts and sleeveless shirts are not permitted. Pants must be appropriately sized and worn with a belt (if there are belt loops on the pants). Solid colors of black, navy blue, or khaki. Blue jeans, leggings worn as pants, hot pants, sweatpants, carpenter pants, athletic pants, etc. are not permitted. Skirts must not be shorter than mid-thigh. Solid colors of black, navy blue, or khaki. In cooler weather, tights/leggings may be worn under skirts that are not shorter than mid-thigh. Jean skirts are not permitted. Walking shorts (boys) and knee-length walking shorts/capris (girls) are to be knee length in solid colors of black, navy blue, and khaki are permitted during warmer months. These items may not be worn from November through Spring. Shoes must be closed toe and attached at the heel. Rubber soled shoes are preferred. High heeled shoes/boots are not permitted. Heels should be 1 inch or less. Hats/Head Coverings: Hats should not be worn at any time inside the building (unless for religious reasons).

The following do not have an established uniform policy. Students are expected to follow the CCS Dress Code as outlined in the CCS Guide to Student Success.

Fort Hayes	 As a member of the Fort Hayes Career Center, our students are expected to maintain professional expectations at all times. For this reason, clothing that reflects a professional mindset is required for all Fort Hayes Career Center students while on our campus. Students who do not dress appropriately will be required to contact a parent and change clothing. Repeat offenders will receive consequences for insubordination. The following are not permitted: Shorts are not permitted on the Fort Hayes Campus at any time. Even if a student's home school allows shorts, students must change into pants when on the Fort Hayes Campus. Capri pants are permitted, but must not be shorter than the bottom of your calf muscle. Slacks, skirts, and pants are allowed. Skirts must be longer than finger-tip length at all times. Even if leggings are worn under a skirt/dress – the skirt/dress must comply with length requirements. See-through blouses, tank tops, tube-tops, and sleeveless muscle shirts or spaghetti straps. Halter tops and bare midriffs are not permitted. Bare feet or flip flops - Sandals must have backs on them. Jeans must be clean, neat, and free of excessive tears. Jeans with tears (shredded jeans) should not be excessive and tears with skin exposure should not fall above the knee. The slit in a dress must not be higher than your knees (finger-tip rule) Leggings may not be worn as pants.

 Clothing/accessories that advertise drugs, alcohol, tobacco,
profanity or negative social statements. Outdoor clothing should
not be worn indoors (hoods, hats, do-rags).
 Sagging is not permitted! Undergarments may not be exposed at
any time.
