Virtual Visits/Telemedicine

If you are covered by Columbus City Schools' medical coverage with UHC, you also have access to Virtual Visits 24/7. Virtual visits allow to meet with a doctor using your smartphone, tablet or computer. You will simply need to pay your copay for a virtual visit. This is an excellent way to get treatment without leaving your home. Virtual Visits are an excellent resource if you are experiencing medical conditions like, sore throat, head aches/migraines, rashes, eye infections and/or coughing. If you think you have been exposed to COVID-19 and develop a fever and symptoms, such as cough or difficulty breathing, call your healthcare provider or closest emergency room for medical advice.

Prescription Drug Coverage Express Scripts

- Should you find yourself in a situation where you've been affected by the COVID-19 virus and need to refill a maintenance drug earlier than the insurance schedule will allow, please call Express Scripts at 1-866-533-7005 and request an override to fill the prescription early.
- Express Scripts also provides a 90-day supply through mail order and your prescriptions will be shipped to your door at no additional cost. If you would like to consider the mail order option, talk to your healthcare provider about sending in a 90-day prescription directly to Express Scripts.
