As a CCS mentor, you will:

- Complete a CCS background check (at the District's expense)
- Complete OSMI mentor training session
- Meet with your student for one-hour each week during the school year
- Complete weekly online mentor activity log
- Work with your student to develop high school and post-high school graduation goals and action plans
- Develop your student's issue spotting and problem-solving skills to help them navigate academic, personal, professional and life circumstances
- Listen, serve as a sounding board, and assist students in living their life by design rather than by default

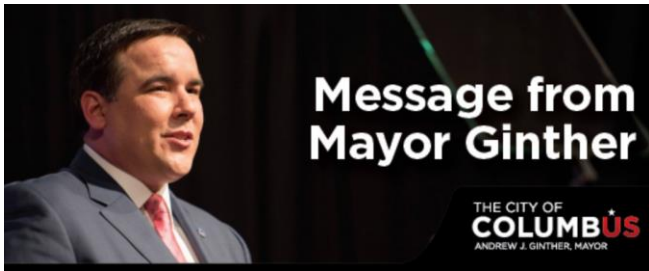
