



hy wait for your future? With Ohio's College Credit Plus (CCP) program, you can earn college and high school credits at the same time... by taking college courses from colleges or universities. And if you take courses from a public college, it's free! The purpose of this program is to promote rigorous academic pursuits and to provide a wide variety of options to college-ready students. Taking a College Credit Plus course from a public college or university is free, which means no cost for tuition, books, or fees. If you choose to attend a private college or university, you may have limited costs.

- Students and parents must submit A Letter of Intent to Participate and have it submitted by April 1, 2022, to take CCP classes in the high school or on campus during the 2022-2023 school year, including summer 2022.
- Families who do not view the online CCP Information video must arrange a separate CCP counseling session with their school prior to participation in CCP.
- Intent to Participate Forms are available after viewing the online presentation.

Any student in grade 6-11 who may be considering CCP courses next year should view the online CCP Information and submit a Letter of Intent by April 1, 2022.
