hy wait for your future? With Ohio's College Credit Plus (CCP) program, The purpose of this program is to promote rigorous academic opportunities to students in grades 7-12 and to provide a wide variety of course options to collegeready students. To participate, students must:

- Attend an in-person session, watch the informational video, or attend a live virtual session. Families who do not complete this step must arrange a separate CCP counseling session with their school prior to participation in CCP.
- Submit a Letter of Intent to participate by April 1, 2023 in order to take CCP classes in their high school, on a college campus, or online.
- Apply to the college/university in which you wish to take CCP courses, adhering to their admission standards and deadlines.
