Air Force JROTC - Terms and Agreement

Air Force JROTC is an elective credit through Fort Haves Arts & Academic High School. It is a unique course of instruction because the Air Force has established certain requirements that must be met before credit can be given. This agreement, like an educational contract, serves to communicate guidelines concerning requirements and encourages a commitment to develop self-discipline and responsibility

It must be understood that participation in Air Force Junior ROTC does not commit or obligate any student to military service. It does not guarantee special consideration if a student chooses to enter the service. However, a cadet who completes three years of Fort Hayes Arts & Academic High School Air Force Junior ROTC program may qualify for advanced rank upon enlistment in the military.

AGREEMENT

I. Upon acceptance of this application and the fulfillment of the conditions on the part of the cadet, the Aerospace Science Instructors agree to:

- A Provide textbook materials
- B. Issue a regulation Air Force uniform to each cadet on a loan basis from the authorized sizes available from the Air Force.
- · C. Provide instruction of the purpose of Air Force Junior ROTC, which is to; 1. Instruct students about the aerospace age.
 - Strengthen and develop character and leadership. 2.
 - 3. Help cadets understand their roles in a democratic society.

 - Familiarize cadets with the USAF and the career opportunities it offers to qualifying graduates.
- D. Assist cadets with their academics and career planning.
- · E. Provide guidance regarding the continuing educational opportunities through the Service academies and college ROTC scholarship programs

II. To maintain the high standards of courtesy, personal conduct, and appearance required by the Air Force and Fort Haves Arts & Academic High School, as a cadet I understand and agree to

- A. Participate and recite the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag, and show proper respect to the flag during raising and lowering ceremonies
- · B. Wear the AF uniform on "Uniform Days" and wear it correctly.
 - Keep my personal grooming in accordance within standards of the Air Force regulations for haircut, facial hair, and jewelry.
 - Shine my shoes with polish and keep them shined. 2
 - 3. Clean my uniform often and ensure it is in proper condition for wearing.
 - Observe the proper military courtesies: salute and verbal greetings.
 - 1st Missed uniform day will result in a "0" for assignment and mandatory conference with parent/guardian 5. 2nd missed uniform day will result in mandatory conference with parent/quardian with principal.

 - 7. 3rd missed uniform day will result in removal from program.

• C. Respond positively to other cadets who have been appointed to leadership positions in the cadet group. Likewise, if appointed to a position of leadership, I will conduct

- H. Dress for Air Force Junior ROTC physical education in the proper Air Force JROTC uniform.
 L. Learn and observe all school rules and expect the same from my peers

• J. Abide by the Cadet Code: "ON MY HONOR AS AN AIR FORCE JUNIOR ROTC CADET. I WILL NOT LIE, CHEAT NOR STEAL AND I WILL NOT TOLERATE THOSE WHO DO '

• K. Conduct myself appropriately while representing the United States Air Force and Fort Hayes Arts & Academic High School in the local community

- L. Do Not use cell phone in class unless you have been given permission
- · M. Abstain from verbal obscenities (profanity/cursing) in or out of uniform
- N. Not store/leave personal items in the classroom.
- O. Use the classroom telephone only when authorized by an instructor.
- · P. Use the classroom computer/projector only when authorized by an instructor.
- Q. Eligible for promotion to the next higher rank provided I am passing Air Force Junior ROTC with a "B" or higher and have a semester with no F's.
- · R. Will not be allowed to participate in fieldtrips unless I am maintaining no F's in any subject.

A cadet may be disenrolled from the Air Force Junior ROTC training by the Senior Aerospace Science Instructor and principal in accordance with AFJROTC 36-2001, paragraph 2.4.1.1.

• a. Failure to maintain acceptable course compliance with Air Force grooming and appearance standards while in either uniform: haircut, shave each day, proper wear of the

- · b. Inaptitude, indifference to training · c. Disciplinary reasons
- . d. Any other reason deemed appropriate by the Senior Aerospace Science Instructor (SASI) and Principal
