School counseling services are available to ALL students, PreK-12, not just those with an emotional disability or in a crisis. It is the counselor's job to make sure that students are happy and doing their best at school. This is a tall order since so many factors go into kids doing well — their ability to focus and pay attention, their relationships with peers and teachers, how well they can manage their feelings and impulses, and their lives outside of school. School counselors can address these issues using individual or small group counseling, as well as classroom guidance lessons.

CHECKLIST: **Key Questions to Ask When Evaluating SUMMER CAMPS**

Exploring and understanding the various Summer Camp options can help you find the right fit for your child. Once you choose an offering, contact (websites provided) the organization to get tips on how to best prepare your child for an enriching experience this summer. The following are some **key questions** that can help you decide whether your child is ready for **Summer Camp**.

- What type of child is successful at this camp? Will a child who doesn't like competitive sports fit in? How about a child who is a bundle of constant energy?
- Do you interview campers? Do you take anyone, or are you more selective?
- How many kids attend each year? How many leave before camp ends? What are some of the reasons for early departures?
- Is your camp accredited by the American Camp Association?
- Do you have experience with campers who have my child's type of learning and thinking differences?
- Is the schedule highly structured, or do kids have a lot of free choice? What is the balance between indoor and outdoor activities? What does a rainy-day schedule look like?
- Do campers go on field trips? To where? How are they supervised?
- What accommodations can I expect the camp to make for my child's needs?
- If I provide strategies that have helped my child deal with learning and thinking differences at home or at school, will your staff use them?
- How does your staff deal with behavior issues? How are kids disciplined?
- What does your staff do if they see a child being picked on or excluded?
- What is the staff-to-camper ratio?
- Who can my child talk to if there's a problem with a counselor or with another child?
- Is there a nurse or someone else on staff to administer medication if needed? Is this done in a confidential way?
- What kind of training is required for your staff? Are your counselors Red Cross certified?
- Have there ever been any serious accidents at your camp? If so, how did the staff handle this?
- Did you fire any camp counselors last year? If so, why?
- Are there opportunities for parents to volunteer at camp?
- Can parents observe their child during the camp day?
- Can you put me in touch with parents of kids who like this camp? Can you put me in touch with the
 parent of a child for whom the camp wasn't a good fit? Can you put me in touch with any parents of
 campers who have learning and thinking differences?




