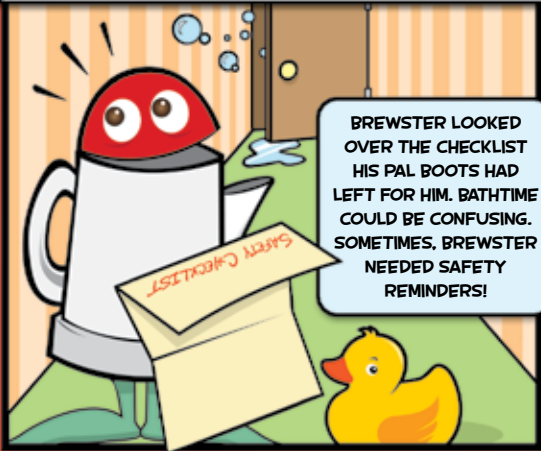

IN TROUBLING TUB TIME!



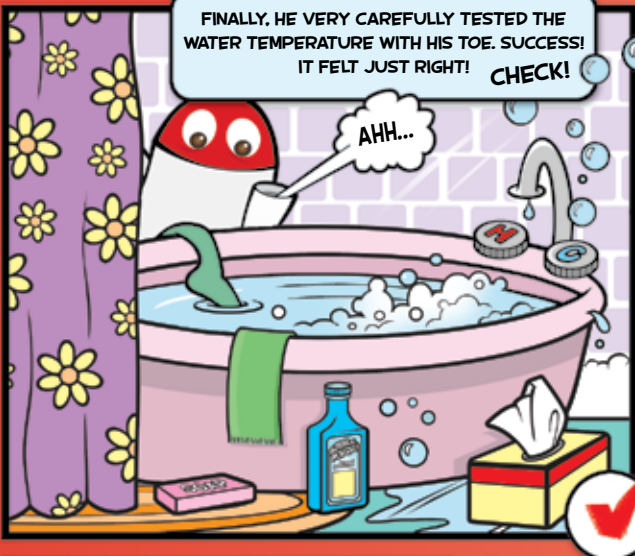

CHECK!

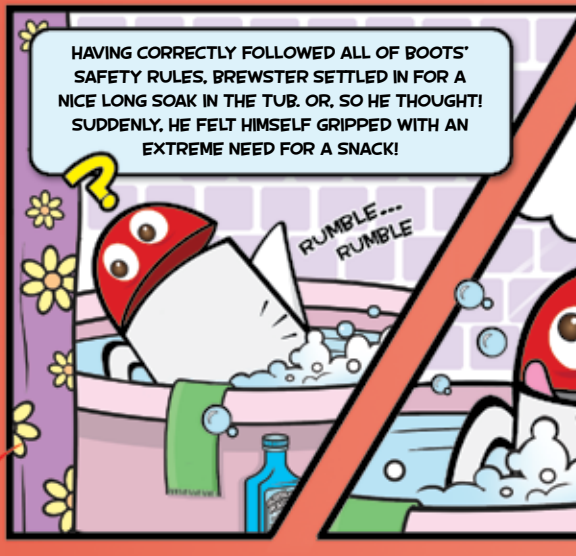


NEXT, HE ADDED THE HOT WATER...
CHECK!

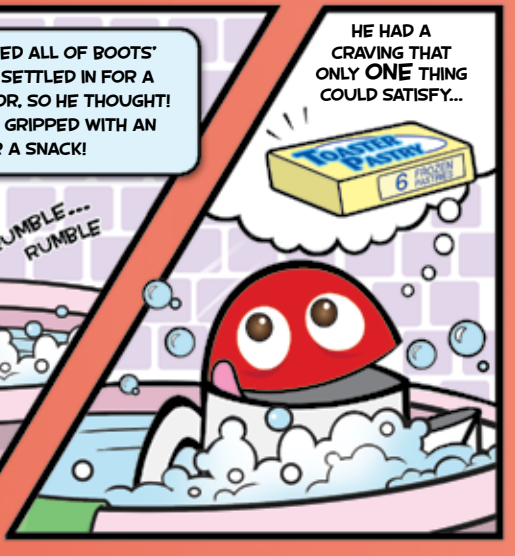

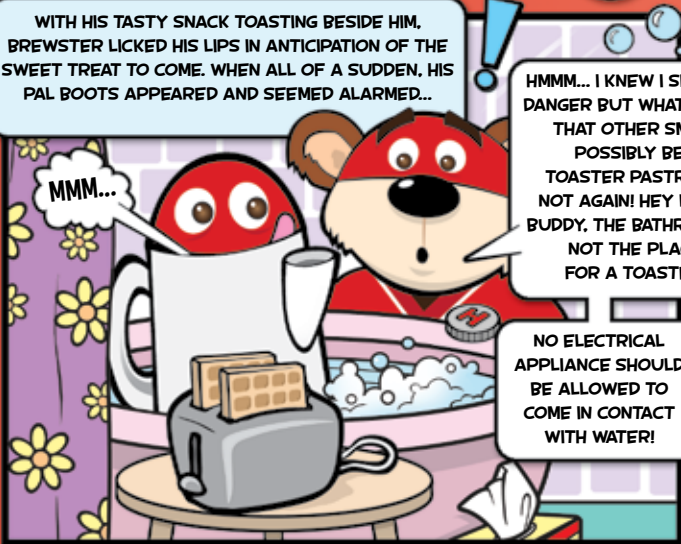
AHH...

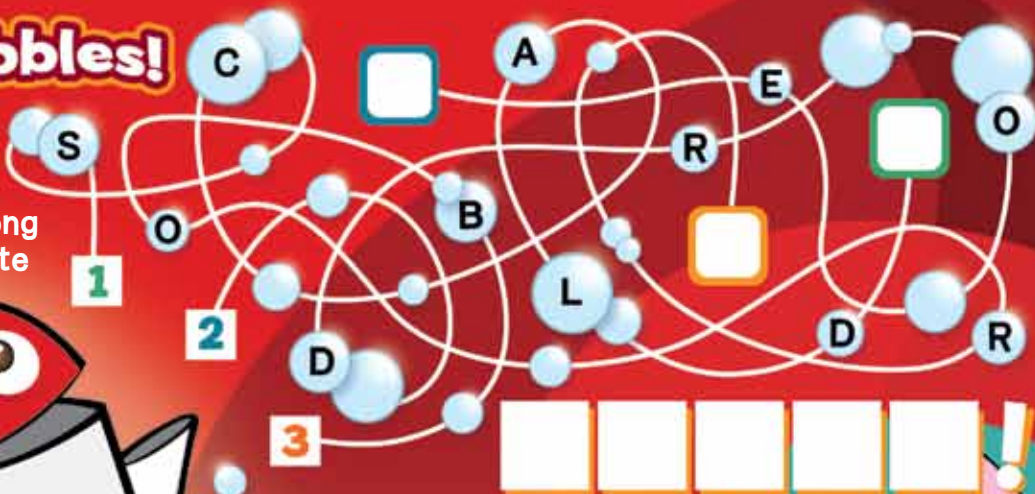

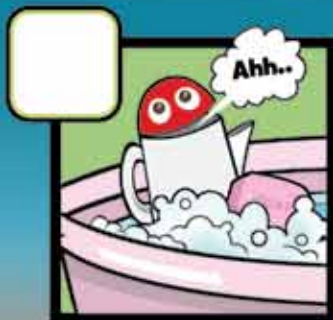

Test the water temperature.



Run cold water in the tub.

Safety Tips!

- 1 Check the water temperature of your bath before you get in.
- 2 Remind your parents to set the water heater's thermostat to 120-125 degrees.

Safety Fact:

A water temperature of 130 degrees can cause a serious burn in only 30 seconds. At 140 degrees, it only takes 5 seconds.

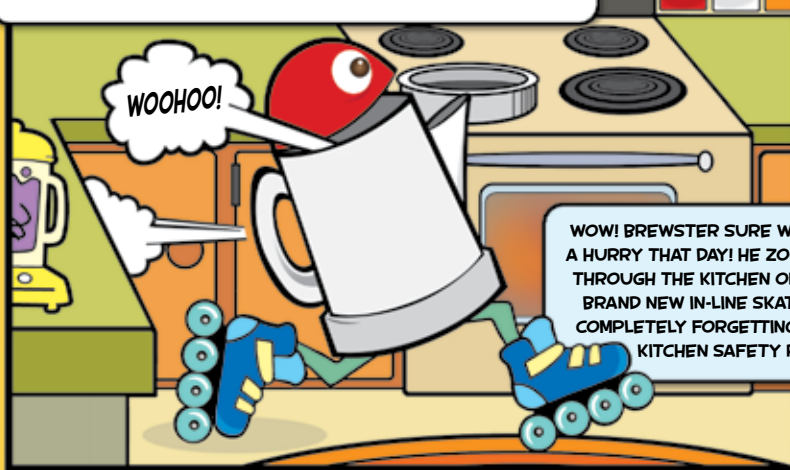

WOOHOO!

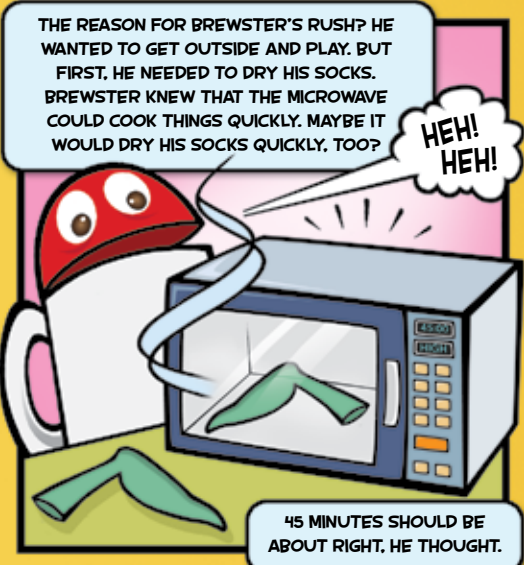

45 MINUTES SHOULD BE ABOUT RIGHT, HE THOUGHT.



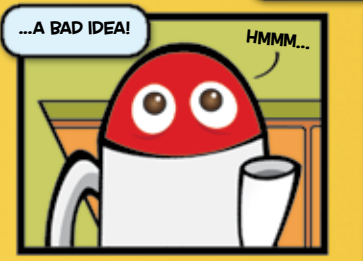
BREWSTER!

LET'S PUT THOSE SOCKS OF YOURS IN THE CLOTHES DRYER WHERE THEY BELONG!

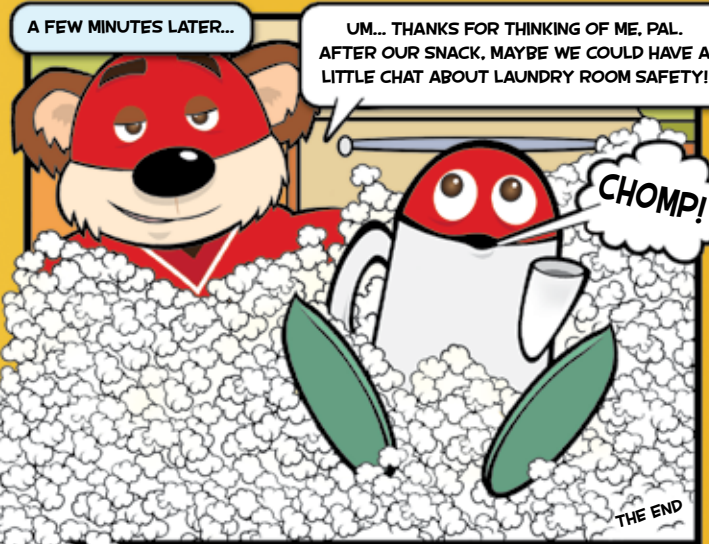

WE CAN HAVE FUN SWEEPING UP WHILE WE'RE THERE!

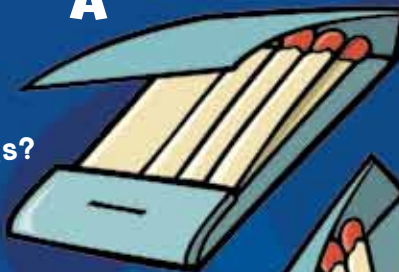
