What Have We Been Up to?

i-Ready MOY Testing

- a. Students in grades 6-8 will complete the middle of the year (MOY) assessment from i-Ready on or before January 21st.
- b. i-Ready is an online program for reading and/or mathematics that will help your student's teacher(s) determine your student's needs, personalize their learning, and monitor progress throughout the school year. i-Ready allows your teacher(s) to meet your student exactly where they are and provides data to increase your student's learning gains.

ALEKS Olympics Competition:

- a. All students are expected to complete ten topics of ALEKS each week (i.e. where appropriate).
- b. ALEKS "maintains a detailed map of each student's knowledge. ALEKS knows, at each moment, with respect to each individual topic in the course, whether the individual student has mastered that topic and if they are ready to learn it now. ALEKS facilitates super-effective learning by offering the student a selection of the topics that they are currently ready to learn".
- c. As an incentive to encourage the completion of 10 topics and more a school-wide competition is taking place. Students have the opportunity to earn prizes individually and collectively as a grade level.

OELPA Preparation:

- a. What is the OELPA?
 - a. The Ohio English Language Proficiency Assessment (OELPA) is the state summative test used to determine an English learner's proficiency level and to exit from the English language program. The OELPA is required for all English learners in addition to Ohio's State Tests.
- b. Students who are taking the OELPA Assessment (January 31, 2022-March 25, 2022) are engaging in practice sessions with Ridgeview teachers weekly.
- c. Each student has an OEPLA Practice Folder with resources to help them prepare for the assessments.
- d. Students who are completing the practice items are being recognized on the daily announcements and receiving prizes.
