Blended Learning Information

- o 6th Graders Return to the Building:
 - Cohort A- March 15th
 - o Cohort B-March 18th
- o 7th and 8th Graders Return to the Building:
 - Cohort A-March 22nd
 - o Cohort B-March 25th
- Students will be in the building two days a week and 3 days at home with Asynchronous
 Assignments. Students still must complete their attendance on Asynchronous Days. <u>Students</u>
 can only come into the building on the days that they are assigned.

Additional Information Regarding Blended Learning at Ridgeview (Note: This information was sent to families via email on 3-3-2021)

- 1. **Recorded RMS Blended Learning Presentation and Office Hours** Next week Ms. James will be sending out a recorded presentation where she will go over a PowerPoint Presentation related to the procedures that will be followed at Ridgeview during Blended Learning. Additionally, she will be hosting office hours for parents to Zoom in and speak with her directly if, they have any questions **after** viewing the recorded presentation.
- 2. What do you need to know <u>now</u> about Blended Learning at Ridgeview? Please see the items below to help you prepare for Blended Learning at Ridgeview:
 - Students will not be allowed in the building before 7:15 a.m. School will be dismissed at 2:30 p.m. Please make sure that all drop off and pick up arrangements are made prior to sending your child to school.
 - Students need to come to school with a combination lock for their locker. Lockers will be socially distanced.
 - Each student <u>must</u> come to school wearing a mask each day and keep it on <u>all day</u> with the exception of while they are eating. Please send your child with an extra mask to school each day. <u>Please note that "neck gaiters" are not allowed and do not take the place of wearing a mask.</u>
 - Students are to come with their district issued Chromebook each day, charged and ready to use. If you did not sign out a district issued Chromebook for your child, then you will need to call our office at 614-365-5506 to set up an appointment to pick one

- up. Note: If a parent/guardian chooses to have their child to bring their own from home they will be responsible for keeping up with the Chromebook.
- Please make sure that you update your contact information in the Parent Portal before your child returns to school.

Transportation

- Those families who are eligible for yellow bus transportation should receive information from the district around March 6th in the parent portal. The district is also mailing postcards to families.
