1. <u>CEREMONY & RECEPTION</u> - WEDNESDAY, MAY 22nd FHMEC THEATRE

 - Students arrive by 4:30 pm in west hallway of the Construction Arts/Auto Tech Center
- **Construction Arts and Auto Technology (6:30 pm ceremony)**
 - ◆ Students arrive at **6:00 pm** in west hallway of the Construction Arts/Auto Tech Center
 - ♦ Parents & families who arrive early may wait in the Performing Arts Choir Room
- **▶** Health Science Programs (8:00 pm ceremony)
 - ♦ Students arrive **by 7:30 pm** in west hallway of the Construction Arts/Auto Tech Center
 - ♦ Parents & families who arrive early may wait in the Performing Arts Choir Room

Each ceremony will be followed by a reception for you and your guests in the Art Gallery of the Shot Tower. If you are late, you may not be able to participate in the ceremony.

3. ELIGILIBILITY

Certificate of Completion

- ♦ Student is successfully completing a 1 or 2 year program.
- Student is a senior successfully completing the first year of a two year program.
- ♦ All fees must be paid (Tickets will be held if fees are not paid)
- ♦ Student must successfully complete their required WebXam.

> Certificate of Participation

♦ Students who did not meet the standards for completer, but have not missed more than 50 days for the year. All program fees must be paid.
