

# **Board of Education Goals**



Strengthen Reading Proficiency

The percentage of third-grade students proficient in Reading on the Ohio State Test (OST) will increase from **34.5%** in school year 2022-2023 to **44.5%** in June of 2028.



### Strengthen Mathematics Proficiency

The percentage of seventh-grade students proficient in Mathematics on the Ohio State Test (OST) will increase from **14.7%** in school year 2022-2023 to **23.45%** in June of 2028.



Closing Opportunity Gaps

The percentage of 4-year graduation cohort students who complete state and district graduation requirements will increase from **78.2%** in August of 2023 to **83.2%** in August of 2028.
