
# April 8, 2024 TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE

# A solar eclipse happens when the moon passes between the Sun and Earth.

As the Moon blocks the Sun's light, it casts a shadow on part of the Earth. When the Moon blocks all of the Sun's light, it is a total eclipse.

- The partial eclipse starts: 1:55 p.m.
- Time of totality: 3:11 p.m.
- Duration of totality: Roughly 2 minutes
- The partial eclipse ends: 4:28 p.m.
