I have gotten the chance to take advanced Math and English courses, which is incredible: I was often bored out of my mind at my original school as we went over similes and multiplication for the umpteenth time, but I am now presented with classes that match my pace of learning, and teachers that understand how gifted scholars will often need individualized attention not to mention the support of our director, who has the name and face of every CGA scholar memorized. At my home school, the principal never even asked me my name. As gifted scholars, our class at CGA has gotten the chance to build strong and positive relationships with each other that I NEVER would have experienced at my home school. We are able to understand and relate to each other as gifted (and often neurodivergent) learners, and no one is ostracized for their differences. CGA has given me a chance to enjoy my developmental years, and has fed my thirst for knowledge in a way that no other school or program ever has."
- "Nowadays, I think that CGA is the reason that I have been able to do all the advanced classes I do, and it is the reason school is fun. At no other school in the district would I have been able to graduate 8th grade with a 11th grade math credit, a 9th grade English credit, and a 9th grade science credit.
