Student Identification Badge

Every student must have a Student Identification Badge. You may use your Badge to ride the city bus (COTA Bus) for free. You may also use your Badge to borrow books from any Columbus Metropolitan Library. If you need a badge, please go to the office.



School Transportation

Students who live more than two miles away from school will be assigned a bus.

If your home address is closer than two miles away, you are not eligible to ride a school bus.

It takes about 10 days after the first day of enrollment to receive your bus route information. Parents are responsible for transportation until the bus is assigned. If you are not able to provide transportation, please inform the office and your student's absences will be excused.

Backpacks

Students are not allowed to carry backpacks in the hallways, unless the backpacks are mesh or clear (transparent).

If your student does not have a mesh or clear backpack, they must store their backpack in their assigned school locker during the school day.

Chromebooks (Student Computers)

Students are not required to have computers to complete homework. They will use computers at the school during the school day, but the chromebooks will remain in the classrooms. Columbus Global will provide all other school supplies.
