I believe the upcoming school year is an monumental and historic opportunity to embrace every child and provide them with the foundation to become adaptable, empathetic, and creative learners.

West High School is committed to the safety of your student(s) as well as providing high-quality culturally relevant instruction in our classrooms. West High School will continue to support our district and region goals:

- **Strengthen Reading Proficiency** - The percentage of third-grade students proficient in Reading on the Ohio State Test (OST) will increase from 43% in School Year 2018-2019 to 55% by June of 2026.
- **Close Opportunity Gaps** - The percentage of 4-year graduation cohort students who complete state and district graduation requirements will increase from 81.2% in August 2020 to 86% in August 2026.
- **Develop Portrait-Ready Graduates** - The percentage of the Class of 2028 who earn the Portrait of a Graduate Seal will increase from 0% in June 2022 to 25% by June 2028.
