ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS:

Avalon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Navy bottoms, light blue or navy polo or dress shirts or blouses with a collar. No khakis. Navy skirts, dresses, jumpers or shorts.
Berwick PreK-8	<p>BOYS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Navy blue pants or knee length shorts - with belt. Shorts may only be worn in May, June, August, and September. NO CARGO PANTS Polo shirts with collars (white, light blue, or light yellow). Short/long sleeved oxford shirts (white, light blue or light yellow). NO NAVY BLUE SHIRTS, NO WRITING ON SHIRTS & NO HOODED SWEATSHIRTS Shirts worn under uniform tops must be of uniform color. Dark blue, light yellow, or white sweaters may be worn with uniforms Socks must be MOSTLY blue, white, or black Sneakers or dress shoes. NO FLIP FLOPS No jewelry should interfere with classroom instruction. <p>GIRLS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Navy blue pants or knee length shorts – with belt. Shorts may only be worn in May, June, August, and September. NO CARGO PANTS Navy blue jumper, skirt, or dress Tights, socks or leggings must be MOSTLY blue, white, or black (NO OTHER COLORS, PRINTS, STRIPES) Polo shirts with collars (white, light blue, or light yellow) Short/long sleeved oxford shirts (white, light blue or light yellow). NO NAVY BLUE SHIRTS, NO WRITING ON SHIRTS & NO HOODED SWEATSHIRTS Shirts worn under uniform tops must be of uniform color. Navy blue, light yellow, or white sweaters may be worn with uniforms. Sneakers or dress shoes. NO FLIP-FLOPS No jewelry should interfere with classroom instruction. <p>Students are to arrive at school in uniform daily. Shirts are to be tucked in and belts are required if pants are fitted with belt loops. Every day is a uniform dress day.</p>

Cassady	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Khaki, navy bottoms, light blue, navy, or white polo tops/blouses with collars. Student's sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets that are worn inside during the school day must be uniform colors. • Students should wear tennis shoes with socks. • If a student comes to school without a uniform, the parent will be called to bring a school uniform for their child. If a uniform is not brought to school, the student will be required to change into a school uniform.
Columbus Africentric Pre-K - 12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PK-5 and Middle School students wear PURPLE polo shirts. • High School students wear BLACK polo shirts. • All students (PK-12) wear khaki bottoms. • Students are not permitted to wear jackets or coats throughout the school day. Students can wear long sleeve black or purple polo shirts but they cannot wear long sleeve shirts under their short sleeve purple or black polo shirts. • PK-12 students who desire to wear layers over their polos during the day throughout our campus will have the option to purchase school (CAEC) sweaters, cardigans and sweatshirts. Note: These are only layered options for students who wish to layer over their purple or black polos. These layer options must be purchased from School Closet / School Days Uniforms online at www.schoolcloset.com or you can visit the store at 73 N. Stygler Rd. Gahanna, Ohio 43230 or 4507 N. High St. Clintonville, Ohio 43214. Optional logo polos are also available for purchase. • Because the temperature varies in our building the administration strongly suggests that each student has 1-2 long sleeve polos and at least one layered option.
Columbus Spanish Immersion Academy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy, Khaki, or Black bottoms. • Any color shirt with a collar.
East Linden	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shirts may be: white, light blue, and dark blue. • Pants may be: black, navy, khaki, and jeans.
Eastgate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shirts: White or black shirts ONLY. Shirts can be polo or oxford style. Students may also wear Eastgate school spirit t-shirts. • Bottoms: Black or Khaki ONLY. • Ties: Students wear orange and black striped ties. Criss-Cross for girls, bow and long neck ties for boys. Ties can be purchased at the School Closet in Gahanna. Ties are NOT optional; they are a part of the school dress code. • Shoes - Closed toe and heel. All colors and types are acceptable.

Easthaven	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy blue or khaki pants, shorts, skirts or shorts. • Solid colored white, light blue, or navy polo style shirts--no stripes, photos, decals or graphics are permitted. (Dress shirts or blouses are permitted). • Students are not permitted to wear coats or jackets in the building and should have a sweater. Students will not be permitted to wear hoodies in the building. • Shoes are to cover the entire foot and be appropriate to safely participate in physical education and recess activities.
Fairmoor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy blue, light blue, or white shirts are permitted. Shirts are to be solid in color (no stripes, photos, decals, graphics, etc...). Polo-style shirts, dress shirts, or blouses are permitted. These can be short-sleeved or long-sleeved. • Navy blue or tan/khaki pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers, and dress pants are permitted. • Shoes are to cover the entire foot and be appropriate to safely participate in physical education and recess activities. Athletic-type shoes are recommended.
Fairwood	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy blue, light blue, yellow or white shirts are permitted. Shirts are to be solid in color (no stripes, photos, decals, graphics, etc...). Polo-style shirts, dress shirts, or blouses are permitted. These can be short-sleeved or long-sleeved. • Navy blue or tan/khaki pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers, and dress pants are permitted. • Shoes are to cover the entire foot and be appropriate to safely participate in physical education and recess activities. Linden STEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bottoms: Uniform style, Khaki, blue or black pants/capris/shorts/skirts/skort, or jumpers. No leggings, NO DENIM MAY BE WORN! • Shorts, skirts, skorts and jumpers should be fingertip length or longer; if belt loops – belt must be worn. • Shirts/Tops: Shirts WITH Collars (Solid Polo or Oxford style)/Blouses WITH Sleeves (Shoulders must be covered - NO TANK TOPS). Colors are forest green, navy blue, light blue, or white. (No WRITING/PICTURES on shirts/tops) • Any Linden Spirit Wear is acceptable. • Shoes: Closed toe shoes, no sandals, athletic sandals or open toe shoes can be worn for student safety
Moler	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Basic solid-color uniform scheme. Students can wear white, black, navy or light blue short sleeved polo, short or long sleeve shirts and blouses. No graphic tees. • Students can wear blue khaki, or black pants, shorts, skirts and/or jumper dresses (must be knee length). • NO flip flops or open toed shoes.
North Linden	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy blue, light blue, yellow, pink or white shirts are permitted. Shirts are to be solid in color (no stripes, photos, decals, graphics, etc...). Polo-style shirts, dress shirts, or blouses are permitted. These can be short-sleeved or long-sleeved. • Navy blue, black or tan/khaki pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers, and dress pants are permitted. • Shoes are to cover the entire foot and be appropriate to safely participate in physical education and recess.
Northtowne	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Columbus City Schools Dress Policy K-5 Pre-K only: • Navy blue, light blue, or white shirts are permitted. Polo-style shirts, dress shirts, or blouses are permitted. These can be short-sleeved or long-sleeved. • Navy blue, black or tan/khaki pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers, and dress pants are permitted. Shoes are to cover the entire foot and be appropriate to safely participate in physical education and recess activities. Athletic-type shoes are recommended.

<p>Oakland Park</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tops: Solid white or navy blue polo shirts/blouses with collar, long or short sleeved. Blouses/shirts must be long enough to be tucked in. No logos or writing. White or navy sweater/vest, sweatshirt or navy Oakland Park Sweatshirts can be worn during cold months. (no hooded sweatshirts may be worn in the building at any time). Navy or red Oakland Park t-shirts may be worn on Fridays only. • Bottoms: Navy blue/khaki pants/skorts/capris/skirts/jumpers. Oversized pants that sag are not permitted. Skirts, shorts and jumpers should be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. Shorts and capris are worn during Aug., Sept., May, and June only. No jeans. • Belts with buckles are required for clothes with belt loops. Navy, black, or brown belts are required. No scarf belts. • Socks/Legwear: Socks must be white, navy blue or black only. Boys socks should be no longer than crew length. Girls who choose to wear knee socks, or tights, must wear white or navy blue only. No design, patterns, stripes, or colors are allowed. Leggings are not to be worn at Oakland Park. • Shoes: Black, brown, or navy school shoes are preferred. Appropriate solid color tennis shoes are allowed (no neon colors, no flashing lights). No heels, flip flops, crocs, open toe shoes, or boots. Shoes should be free of graphic designs such as skulls and other inappropriate images. • Jewelry: Earrings must be post, no dangling. Necklaces should be no longer than 14" and no costume, plastic, or play jewelry is allowed. No bracelets or rings of any kind are to be worn.

<p>Olde Orchard</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy blue, light blue, or white shirts are permitted. Polo-style shirts, dress shirts, or blouses are permitted. These can be short-sleeved or long-sleeved. School Panda pride t-shirts are also permitted. • Navy blue, black or tan/khaki pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers, and dress pants are permitted. No jeans. • Shoes are to cover the entire foot and be appropriate to safely participate in physical education and recess activities. Athletic-type shoes are recommended.

Any Scottwood spirit wear is acceptable.

Oversized pants that sag are not permitted and belts must be worn. Skirts, shorts and jumpers should be knee length. No jeans, jogging suits or sweatpants. Appropriate shoes (no heels, no flip flops, no slides, or open toe shoes). No slogans, logos or writing on shirts.
Valley Forge	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Navy Blue, Khaki, or Black pants, skirts, or jumpers. Shorts and Skirts may be no shorter than three inches above the knee. SOLID color Light Blue, Yellow, or White Shirts. Pants must be worn at the waist and secured with a belt.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hats, do-rags, or any head coverings that are not required by religion are not permitted in the building. • Purses are not permitted in school, unless required for personal hygiene reasons. • Sensible shoes are suggested. <p>Dominion</p>	<p>The dress code is a primary means of helping students and families understand that there are requirements related to dress in the business world for success in securing and maintaining employment. On August 16, 2005 the Columbus Board of Education approved two policies that, when implemented, will help to ensure a positive climate for learning in all our schools. The purpose of the Dominion dress code is to provide guidance to students and parents regarding appropriate attire for school and at any school functions. The first district wide policy expects all students to adhere to a code of decent dress for school. Students are not to wear clothing that could compromise their personal safety or the safety of others.</p> <p>Specific provisions include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Undergarments must be concealed at all times. • Clothing should be “business world” appropriate: (No bare midriffs or see-through clothing, private areas appropriately kept private, no night or sleeping clothes; and no underwear as outerwear • RIP (rest in peace) shirts may be an emotional trigger for another student, so shouldn’t be worn to school. • Head covering worn in the building should serve a religious purpose. Sunglasses may not be worn inside. • Pants must be worn at the waist. No excessively saggy pants or excessively short shorts. Long pants must be of proper waist size and must not hang below the waist, with pants not touching or dragging on the ground;

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Belts must fit properly and not be more than three inches longer than the student’s measured waist size; • Clothing and jewelry shall be free of writing, pictures, or any other insignia which are crude, vulgar, profane, sexually suggestive, or which advocate negative racial, ethnic, gender or religious prejudice, or use or glorification of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, or violence. Dress should not be disruptive. • Purses, fanny packs and book bags will be kept locked in student lockers. • Appropriate footwear include shoes that cover the heel. House slippers and “flip flop”, pool shoes or athletic sandals aren’t appropriate for school. • The principal has discretion over the dress code.
Johnson Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shirts: Solid black, navy, red, or white collared, short or long sleeve shirt • Bottoms: Solid black, navy or khaki at or below the knee • Belt required • Shoes - closed toe, gym shoe, dress shoe, that is safe and appropriate to the learning environment and aligned with Columbus City Schools Dress Code policy • Sweaters and cardigans must be solid black, navy, red, or white. Students are not allowed to wear any other outerwear during the school day. No hoodies, jackets, coats, or fleece, no do-rags, bandanas or bonnets. No book bags or large purses will be worn during the school day.
Medina	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CCS dress code policy. NO SOLID RED and NO SOLID BLUE T-shirts are to be worn at any time. In addition, students are NOT PERMITTED to wear tank tops or flip flops. • Any blouse, shirt or clothing material that has a hood MUST NOT be worn. ALL clothing with a ‘hood’ must be removed and placed in lockers. • Book bags and large purses or large ‘Fanny packs’ WILL NOT be carried during school hours.
Mifflin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tops: Short or long sleeve polos or oxfords in baby blue, navy blue and white. No logos, hoods, denim, athletic outerwear jackets, no hoodies, shirts, sweaters, sweatshirts, see through tops, undergarments or t-shirts exposed, no long sleeves under polos unless they are baby blue, navy blue or white. All shirts must be tucked in and have a collar. • Bottoms: Pants/ cotton or Twill, Shorts must have pockets. Length, no shorter than fingertip length • Skirts/Jumpers must be top of the knee or longer, Colors Khaki, Navy, or Black

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No Jeans, Denim, yoga/stretch pants, corduroy, sweats/or wind pants, no side zippers, or rivets on front or rear pockets, no cargo pants or shorts, No jogger pants, pajama pants, jeggings or leggings, no tights or fitted skirts, no oversized clothing. • All bottoms will be fitted and hemmed and must be worn at the waist. • Sweaters: Can be V Neck, Crew Neck or Cardigans with buttons or zippers in Navy, White, Gray, or Black. Ridgeview	<p>The school and CCS dress codes are intended to prevent disruption to the educational process. This policy is also intended to promote a positive school and classroom atmosphere, enhance decorum, eliminate disturbances and minimize distractions to students and staff. All clothing and accessories shall be within the bounds of decency and good taste and appropriate for school. Clothing shall be sufficient to conceal undergarments at all times. The principal shall have the authority to further define dress code requirements for their individual school. All students shall abide by the following dress code:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All clothes must be sized appropriately and may not be tight, form fitting or oversized. No sleepwear or see through clothing is permitted. All clothing and accessories shall be free of writing, pictures or any other insignia which are crude, vulgar, profane, sexually suggestive or which advocate negative racial, ethnic, gender or religious prejudice, or use or glorification of drugs, sex, tobacco, alcohol or violence. • Dresses, shorts and skirts shall be within the bounds of decency and good taste and not shorter than mid-thigh, defined as 4" above the knee, and must have no writing across the seat area. • Pants and shorts are to be free of tears or holes and no bigger than 1" larger than the correctly measured student waist size and must be worn at the student's natural waistline. Pants cannot be gathered or drawn together at the waist or ankle. Pant length should not touch or drag on the ground. Shorts must be hemmed and straight legged. Athletic shorts are not permitted unless during

physical education class or activity. Sagging will not be permitted. A belt, strap or zip tie should be worn the entire school day if needed for pants/shorts to remain at the waist.

- Tops must be worn at all times and must be sized appropriately. Undershirts may not be worn as outerwear, may not be low cut; see through, off the shoulder or otherwise revealing. Tube tops, spaghetti strap tops, tank tops, halter tops and/or any strapless top or dress are not permitted. No bare midribs permitted. As a test for appropriate length, student bodies shall not be exposed when arms are raised above their heads.
- Shoes must be worn at all times and should protect the feet from injury. Flip-flops, slippers/bedroom shoes and beach shoes are not permitted. Rubber soles are recommended.
- Hats, slumber bonnets, "do-rags", caps and other types of head covering (other than for religious purposes) and Outerwear shall not be worn inside the building. Hoodies may not be worn over the head inside the building. Hair rollers may not be worn inside the building.
- Accessories and hair color are to be decent and appropriate for school. Accessories may not be oversized, noisy, gaudy or otherwise distracting. Chains and spikes are not permitted. Backpacks/backpack purses, knapsacks, fanny packs, oversized purses, sunglasses, gloves, scarves, headphones/earbuds, earmuffs, etc. may not be worn inside the school. Belts are to be no longer than 3" larger than the student's correctly measured waistline. Any accessory that may be considered a distraction or danger will be restricted.
- Gang Symbols and Gang-Related Apparel shall be defined as apparel that, if worn or displayed, could be determined or affiliate the student as a part of a gang and/or threaten the health and safety of the student or school environment. The administration may prohibit the presence of any apparel, jewelry, accessory or manner of grooming which, by virtue of its color, arrangement, trademark, or any other attribute denotes membership in such a group. (i.e., wearing or possession of chains, rags, bandannas, stocking caps, long belts, baggy/oversized pants, cutoff or saggy pants, pants worn very low below the waist, fronts, etc.) Any student wearing or carrying overt gang paraphernalia or making gestures that symbolize gang membership shall be referred to the building principal or assistant principal.

In cases of dress code violations and questionable dress (not explicitly covered in these guidelines) the student will be counseled by a teacher,

	<p>counselor, or administrator and appropriate corrective and/or disciplinary action taken, including, when necessary, a home contact seeking parental cooperation and assistance. Students will also be requested to change into appropriate clothing or be issued alternative clothing (i.e. a school t-shirt), if necessary. Repeat infractions will result in appropriate discipline. Students are responsible for adhering to all dress code policies contained within the CCS Guide to Student Success and those outlined in the Ridgeview Middle School Student Handbook.</p>
<p>Sherwood</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shirts must be collared, appropriately sized, and a solid color of black, navy blue, or white. Solid colored sweaters/crew neck sweatshirts may be worn in cooler weather. Sherwood spirit shirts are also permitted. Hooded sweatshirts and sleeveless shirts are not permitted. • Pants must be appropriately sized and worn with a belt (if there are belt loops on the pants). Solid colors of black, navy blue, or khaki. Blue jeans, leggings worn as pants, hot pants, sweatpants, carpenter pants, athletic pants, etc. are not permitted. • Skirts must not be shorter than mid-thigh. Solid colors of black, navy blue, or khaki. In cooler weather, tights/leggings may be worn under skirts that are not shorter than mid-thigh. Jean skirts are not permitted. • Walking shorts (boys) and knee-length walking shorts/capris (girls) are to be knee length in solid colors of black, navy blue, and khaki are permitted during warmer months. These items may not be worn from November through Spring. • Shoes must be closed toe and attached at the heel. Rubber soled shoes are preferred. High heeled shoes/boots are not permitted. Heels should be 1 inch or less. • Hats/Head Coverings: Hats should not be worn at any time inside the building (unless for religious reasons).

Fort Hayes	<p>As a member of the Fort Hayes Career Center, our students are expected to maintain professional expectations at all times. For this reason, clothing that reflects a professional mindset is required for all Fort Hayes Career Center students while on our campus. Students who do not dress appropriately will be required to contact a parent and change clothing. Repeat offenders will receive consequences for insubordination. The following are not permitted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shorts are not permitted on the Fort Hayes Campus at any time. Even if a student's home school allows shorts, students must change into pants when on the Fort Hayes Campus. Capri pants are permitted, but must not be shorter than the bottom of your calf muscle. • Slacks, skirts, and pants are allowed. Skirts must be longer than finger-tip length at all times. Even if leggings are worn under a skirt/dress – the skirt/dress must comply with length requirements. See-through blouses, tank tops, tube-tops, and sleeveless muscle shirts or spaghetti straps. Halter tops and bare midriffs are not permitted. • Bare feet or flip flops – Sandals must have backs on them. • Jeans must be clean, neat, and free of excessive tears. Jeans with tears (shredded jeans) should not be excessive and tears with skin exposure should not fall above the knee. • The slit in a dress must not be higher than your knees (finger-tip rule) • Leggings may not be worn as pants.
