REMEMBERING OUR ROLES

FACILITIES TASK FORCE

Review data and make recommendations on schools and administrative buildings for closing or changing attendance boundaries and/or grade configurations.

Provide recommendations that have a statement of rationale.

Recommendations will be based on overall balance and objectivity of factors listed in Board Policy 7105.

Issue draft report to the Board of Education by the end of August. Final report by October.

INTERNAL WORK GROUPS

Provide the Facilities Task Force with understanding of current District environment.

Recommend process for screening based on national best-practice, local historical work, and District subject-matter expertise.

Provide qualitative and quantitative data based on criteria listed by Board Policy and requested by Task Force.

Offer opportunities for public input and provide community access to information reviewed by Task Force.







SCENARIO 4

RECOMMENDATION:

Move Columbus North International into the former Brookhaven High School to co-locate with the current Columbus Global Academy to fully utilize Brookhaven site and advance FMP recommendation...

AND EITHER

...move Dominion Middle School (over-capacity) into larger North High School site.

OR

...move Dominion Middle School into larger North High School site, expand Dominion to include new Immersion Program for 6-8 grades, and move Grade 6 from Columbus Spanish Immersion Academy and Ecole Kenwood French Immersion to provide improved academic options.

OR IF NO MOVE ON DOMINION

...move Columbus Alternative High School into more accommodating North High School site.





TASK FORCE ACTION VOTE ON SCENARIO 4

Move Columbus North International into Brookhaven High School to co-locate with Columbus Global Academy and move Dominion Middle School into North High School site. 
RECOMMENDATION:

- Convert Marion-Franklin High School into Marion Franklin Middle School, and
- Move Grades 9-12 from Marion-Franklin to South High School, and
- Close Buckeye Middle School (with students sent to new Marion-Franklin Middle School), and
- Convert South High School 7-12 into high school only (9-12), and
- Move South's 7-8 Grades to Marion-Franklin Middle School, and
- Move Grade 6 from Fairwood K-6, Lincoln Park K-6, Livingston K-6, Moler K-6, Stewart K-6, and Southwood K-6, and
- Change feeder pattern for Cedarwood Elementary, Parsons Elementary, and Watkins
 Elementary to go to Marion-Franklin Middle School (instead of Buckeye Middle School), and
- Close Siebert Elementary, and
- Adjust attendance boundaries for Southwood Elementary and Stewart Elementary to cover former Siebert neighborhood boundaries.





Convert Marion-Franklin into Middle School, create new South High School Feeder Pattern, close Buckeye Middle School and Siebert Elementary, adjust enrollment and attendance boundaries for remaining elementary schools to PreK-5 (where possible).
