#### Legal Requirement

- O.R.C. §5705.391 and O.A.C. 3301-92-04
- Adopt prior to October 31 of each fiscal year
- Update between April 1 and May 31 of each fiscal year
- Update when events take place that will significantly change the forecast



#### How to read a Five-Year Forecast

- "A forecast is somewhat like a painting of the future based upon a snapshot of today."
- "...the further into the future the forecast extends, the more likely it is that the projections will deviate from actual experience."



#### How to read a Five-Year Forecast

(Source: Ohio Department of Education)

- "A variety of events will ultimately impact the latter years of the forecast, such as state budgets ..."
- "...encourages district management teams to examine future years' projections and identify when challenges will arise."



#### **Forecasting Environment**

- Numerous variables which are difficult to predict
- Exogenous variables over which CCS has little to no control
- Uncertainties of the future contribute to actual experience being different than projected

1<sup>st</sup> calendar year of additional tax revenue from the 5.58 mill operating levy that was approved November 2016.

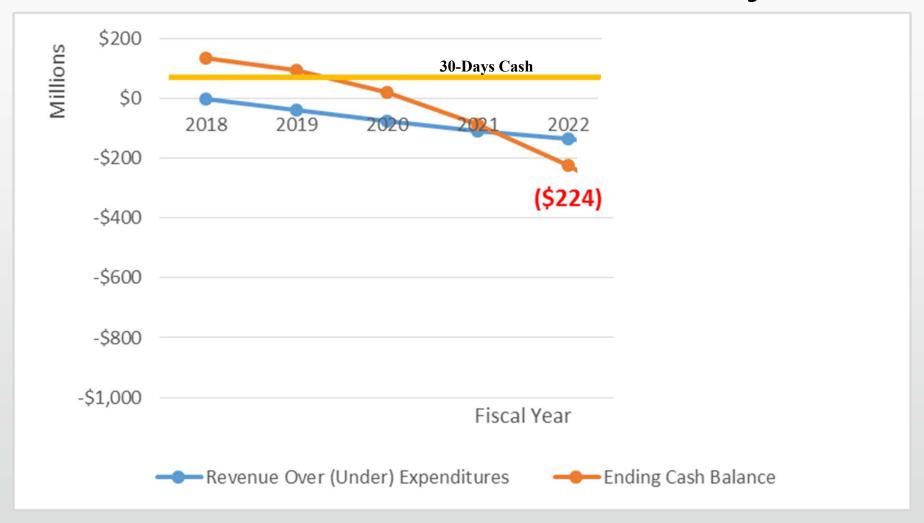

**capped at +4%** growth per year based on state biennial budget for FY2018 & FY2019.

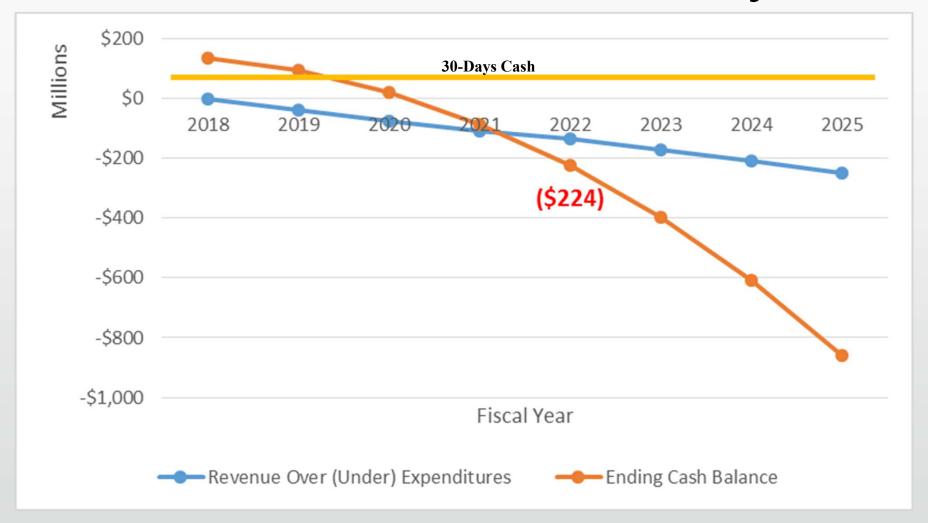

**Included additional personnel** funded by the November 2016 levy.

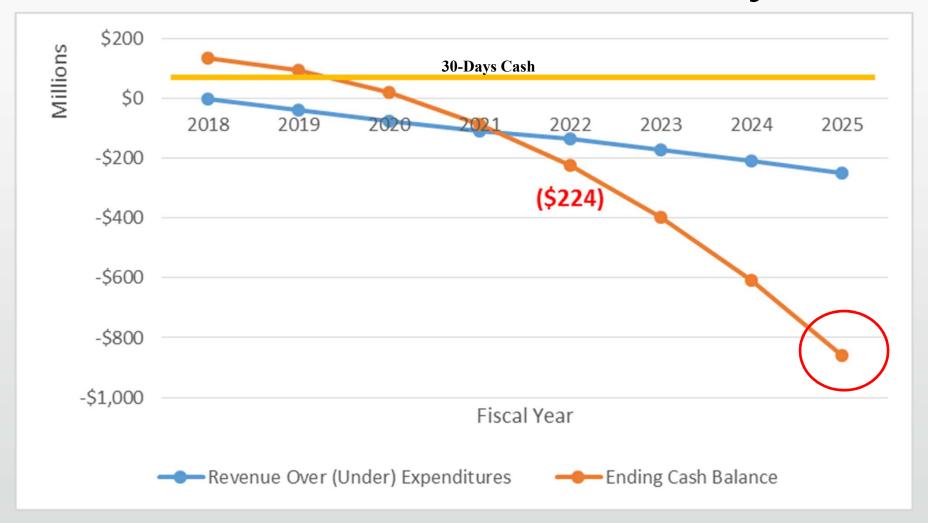




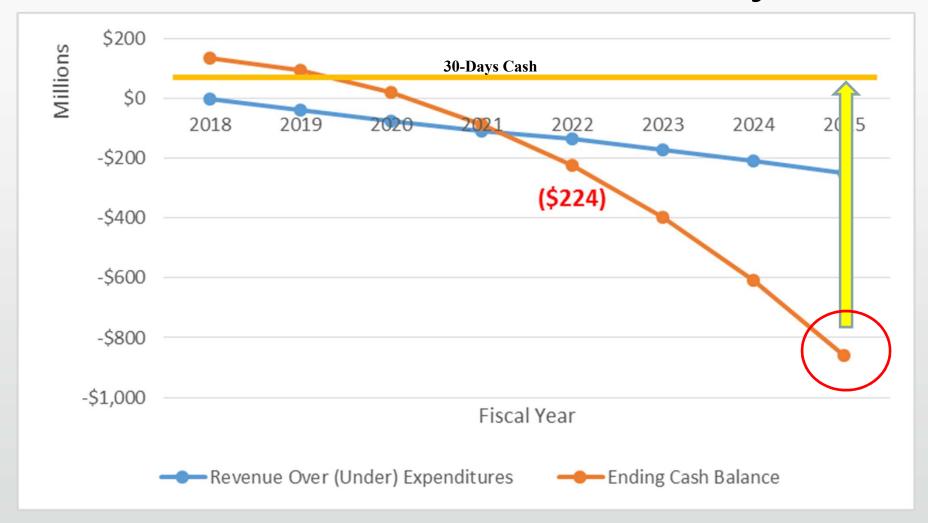














#### October 2017 to April 2018

- Budget Reductions
  - Personnel \$13.1 million
    - Allocated Levy Positions in FY21
    - Reduced administrative, teaching & support staff
  - Non-personnel: \$5.3 million reduction
- Update to include anticipated FY18 favorable variances

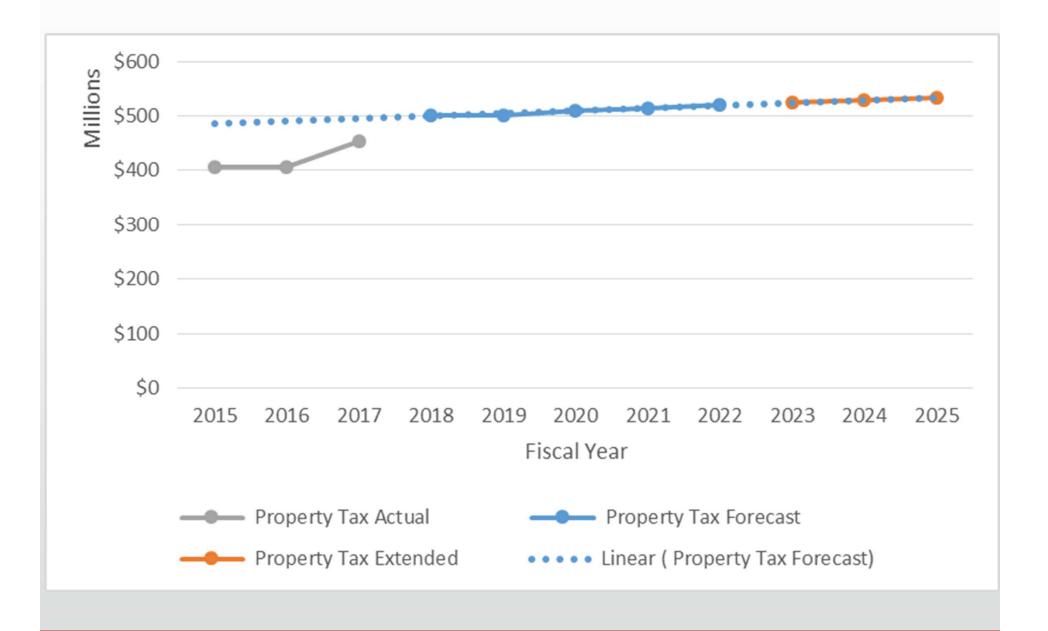

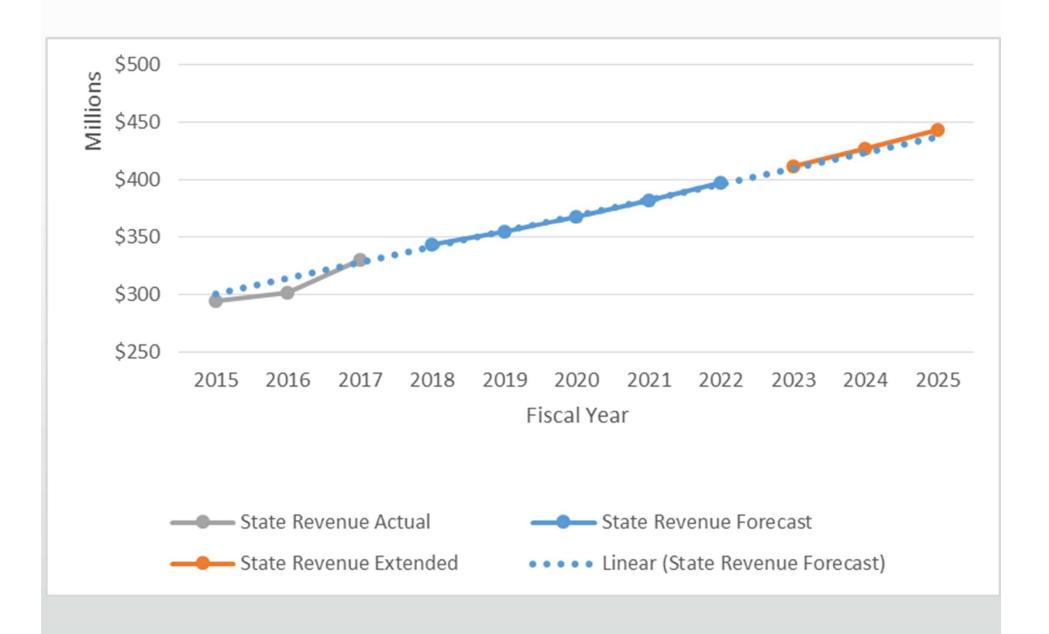




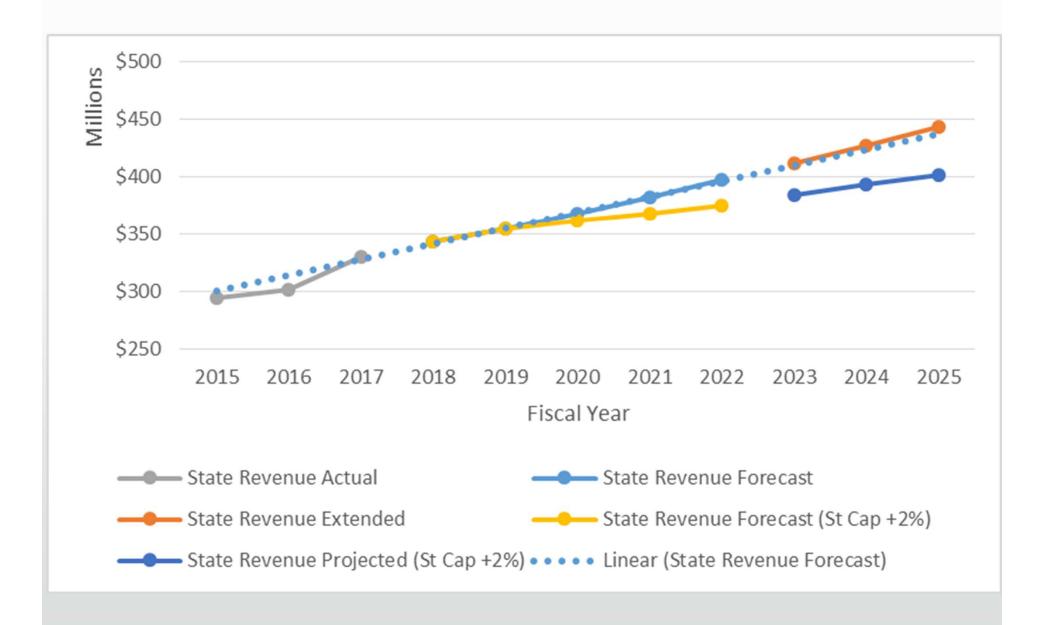


Scenario: State Cap +2%

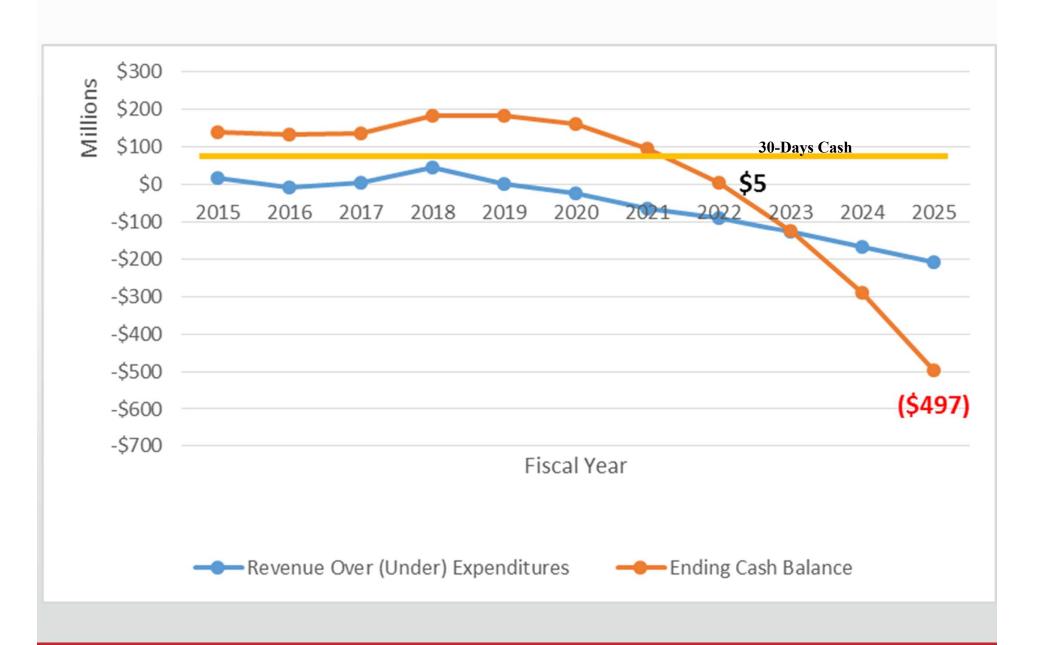




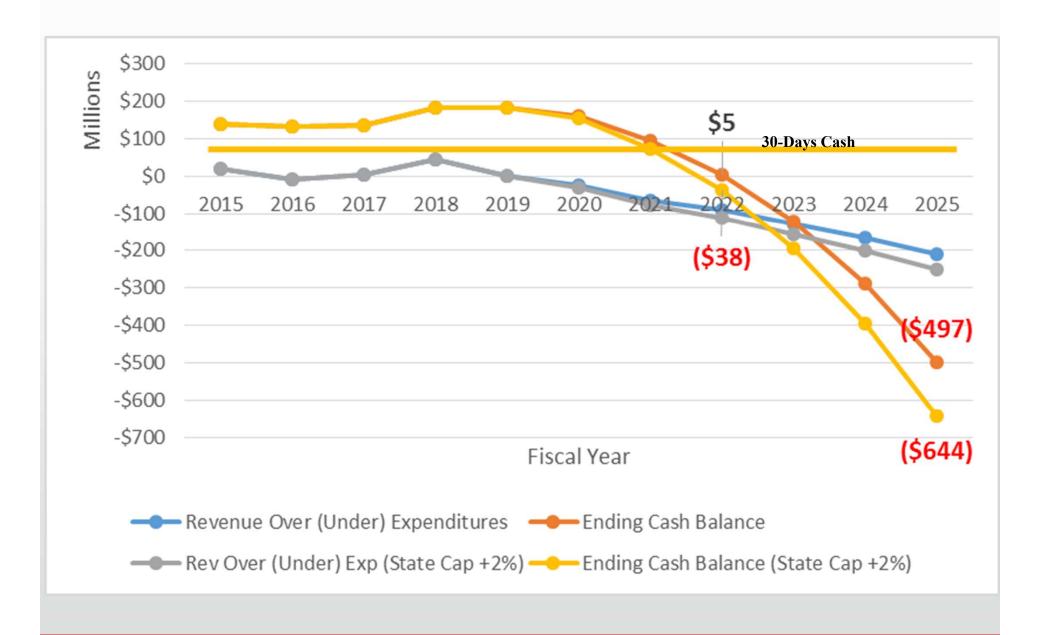








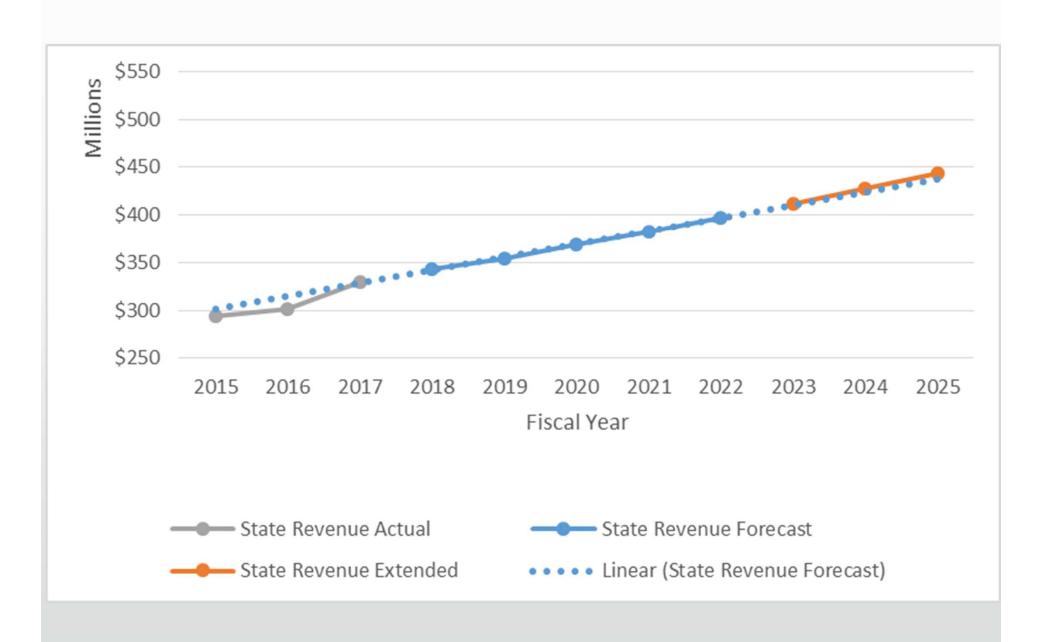




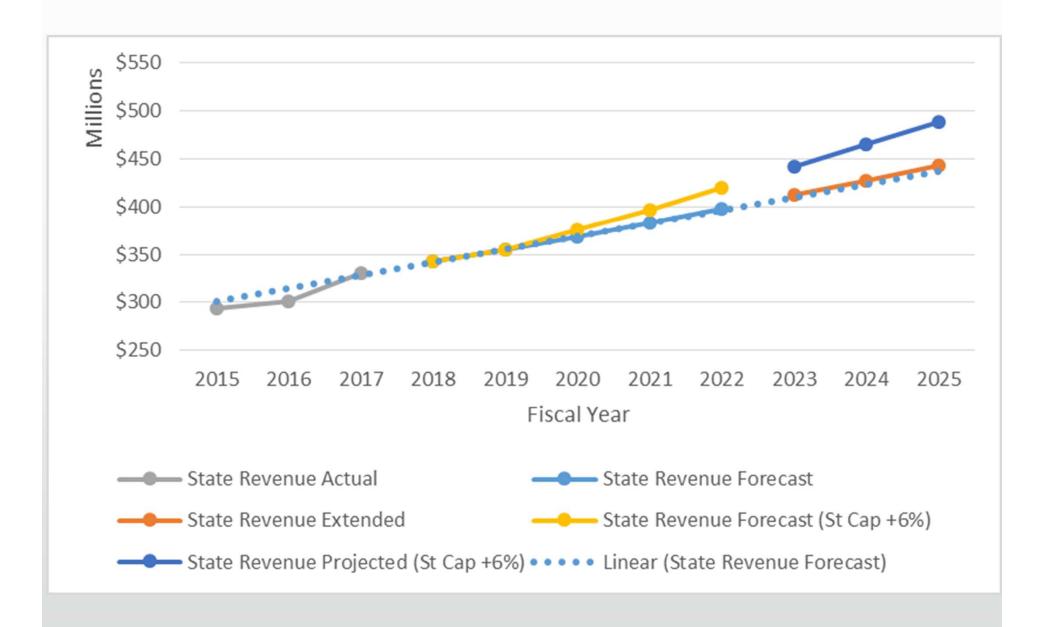
