End-of-course tests are: English I, English II, Integrated Math I, Integrated Math II, Biology (or Phys. Sci. for class of 2018), American Government, and American History. Minimum of four points in math, four points in English and six points across science and social studies.  SCORES: English I English II Math I Biology (or Phys. Sci. c/o 2018 only)  Amer. History Amer. History Amer. Government and Mover More Readiness: Earn a minimum of 12 points by receiving a State Board of Education-approved, industry-recognized credential or group of credentials in a single career field and earn a 13 on WorkKeys, a work-readiness test. The state of Ohio will pay one time for you to take the WorkKeys test.  CREDENTIAL/S  SCORE  College and Career Readiness Tests: Earn the "remediation-free" scores* on either SAT or ACT. Required SAT scores: Writing - 430 or higher, Mathematics - 520 or higher, Reading - 22 or higher. CCS has chosen the ACT for all students in the district to take for free during a one-time statewide spring test in grade 11. *Please note: Ohio's university presidents set these scores, which are subject to change.  SCORES: ACT English Math Reading SAT: Writing Math Reading
