State College and Career Readiness Requirement (must meet at least one option)	Ohio Graduation Test (class of 2017 only): Score proficient on Math, Reading, Writing, Science, and Social Studies. Ohio's State Tests: Earn at least 18 points on seven end-of-course state tests. End-of-course tests are: English I, English II, Integrated Math I, Integrated Math II, Biology (or Phys. Sci. for class of 2018), American Government, and American History. Minimum of four points in math, four points in English and six points across science and social studies. Your school and district receive grades on the Ohio School Report Cards for all students' scores and participation on state tests. SCORES: English I English II Math II Biology (or Phys. Sci. c/o 2018 only) Amer. History Amer. Government Industry Credential and Workforce Readiness: Earn a minimum of 12 points by receiving a State Board of Education-approved, industry-recognized credential or group of credentials in a single career field and earn a 13 on WorkKeys, a work-readiness test. The state of Ohio will pay one time for you to take the WorkKeys test. CREDENTIAL/S SCORE College and Career Readiness Tests: Earn the "remediation-free" scores* on either SAT or ACT. Required SAT scores: Writing - 430 or higher, Mathematics - 520 or higher, Reading - 450 or higher. ACT: English - 18 or higher, Mathematics - 22 or higher, Reading - 22 or higher. CCS has chosen the ACT for all students in the district to take for free during a one-time statewide spring test in grade 11. *Please note: Ohio's university presidents set these scores, which are subject to change. SCORES: ACT English Math Reading SAT: Writing Math Reading										
Diploma and Certification Type (awarded based on completed	 Diploma of Graduation: Earn all 22 required credits indicated in parentheses and meet at least one of the College and Career Readiness requirements above. Diploma of Distinction: Earn at least 24 credits, meet the CCS Diploma of Graduation requirements and have four (4.0) credits in Social Studies, four (4.0) credits in Science, and three (3.0) credits in the same world language which may replace three (3.0) General Elective credits. Diploma with Honors: Awarded to students who meet criteria set by the state of Ohio. There are three types of Honors Diplomas. –see ODE's "Comparison of Diplomas with Honors Criteria" Certification of College Preparatory: Awarded to students who meet CCS Diploma of Graduation requirements and have two (2.0) credits in the same World Language Certification of Specialization: Awarded to students who earn five or more credits in any one specific area of study - academic or elective.
