CREDITS COMPLETED CCS high school Diploma of Graduation: Students must successfully complete courses and meet at least one of the options below to show that they are college or career ready. Diploma of Graduation requirements are listed in parentheses. Up to 2.0 electives may be taken during students' 8 <sup>th</sup> grade year for high school credit. P.E. 2 and Health are permitted to be scheduled in grades 9-12 only. World Languages are recommended but not required for graduation. *Recommended Science course sequence is below, students who meet course prerequisites may take more challenging path. Required credits in parentheses. <i>Italicized</i> courses identify a SAMPLE pathway for the Diploma of Graduation.

Diploma and Certification Type (awarded based on completed courses)	<ul> <li>Diploma of Graduation: Earn all 22 required credits indicated in parentheses and meet at least one of the College and Career Readiness requirements above.</li> <li>Diploma of Distinction: Earn at least 24 credits, meet the CCS Diploma of Graduation requirements and have four (4.0) credits in Social Studies, four (4.0) credits in Science, and three (3.0) credits in the same world language which may replace three (3.0) General Elective credits.</li> <li>Diploma with Honors: Awarded to students who meet criteria set by the state of Ohio. There are three types of Honors Diplomas. –see ODE's "Comparison of Diplomas with Honors Criteria"</li> <li>Certification of College Preparatory: Awarded to students who meet CCS Diploma of Graduation requirements and have two (2.0) credits in the same World Language Certification of Specialization: Awarded to students who earn five or more credits in any one specific area of study - academic or elective.
