- Scholarships are awarded for three consecutive trimesters (PN) or two consecutive semesters (HVACR)
- Allocation of funds will be directly paid to Adult & Community Education.
- Student will be responsible for books, supplies, uniforms, and fees. If applicable, Pell Grant may be used to cover associated program expenses.

Criteria for scholarships:

- Columbus City Schools 2023 graduating/graduated senior.
- Official Transcript of High School Graduation.
- Grade Point Average will be a consideration in our review process. However, all graduates are encouraged to apply.
- Copy of 2022-2023 FASFA Student Aid Report (SAR).
- One letter of recommendation from a school counselor, teacher, school administrator, employer, community leader, or religious leader.
- Statement of Purpose.

Procedure:

- Each application will be evaluated by staff from the Columbus City Schools Adult & Community Education Program.
- Applications that do not meet all criteria will not be considered.
- If determined to be a finalist for the scholarship, applicant(s) will need to take part in a final interview.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by June 1, 2023.
