ADULT WORKFORCE EDUCATION

Achieved the Council on Occupational Education (COE) completion, placement, and licensure benchmarks for the Practical Nursing (PN) Program

Conducted the COE Self-Study and hosted the Visiting Team virtually in preparation for the reaffirmation of accreditation in 2021

Administered the PN admissions assessment (HESI) to 87 individuals

Processed the awarding of Pell Grants for Adult Workforce Education students, in the amount of \$356,301

Disbursed \$679,891 in Federal Direct Loan Program funds

Received an 81.82% pass rate on the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses for 2020

Served 154 and graduated 77 students in the Practical Nurse Program

Submitted all Adult Workforce Education course information to the Ohio Department of Higher Education which generated \$444,582

Received a Center for Training Excellence Grant, in the amount of \$68,692, to develop custom/contract/business services

Received Carl D. Perkins funding from the federal Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V), in the amount of \$128,073, to support Career-Technical and Adult Education

Served 60 students in our ed2go on-line courses

Provided online career training programs for nine (9) students in the following areas: High School Diploma with General Career Preparation; Certified Clinical Medical Assistant for the Experienced CMAA; Medical Terminology; Certified Phlebotomy Technician; HVAC/R Technician; Residential Electrician; Veterinary Assistant

Received funding, in the amount of \$679,409, from the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act's Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund to provide emergency financial aid grants to Practical Nursing students and cover institutional expenses related to the COVID-19 pandemic

Received funding from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act to provide direct emergency grants to CCS-ACE and distributed \$256,054 to Practical Nurse students whose lives have been disrupted by COVID-19

Shifted from a traditional to a hybrid delivery of instruction, which included distance learning, to help ensure timely program completion

Received tuition support (up to \$17,500 per student) from the Workforce Development Board of Central Ohio - Accelerate Career Success program for five Practical Nursing students who completed the PN program

Led the school district with the first in-person learning model following Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Columbus City Schools pandemic quidelines

Received approval from the Ohio Department of Higher Education for the Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning/Refrigeration (HVAC/R) program and Microsoft Outlook

ADULT DIPLOMA PROGRAM

Enrolled 18 students in the Adult Diploma Program (ADP)

Awarded an Ohio-issued High School Diploma to 4 graduates who also earned an industry credential

Received funding, in the amount of \$13,900, from the Ohio Department of Education

Processed the awarding of eighty-two (82) diplomas for completion of the Ohio 22+ Adult High School Diploma Program

ASPIRE

Received approval for the FY 2022 Aspire Grant Applications (Ohio Adult Workforce Readiness Education - \$1,080,000 & Integrated English Literacy and Civics Education - \$50,000)

Issued 187 General Educational Development (GED) test vouchers, which equal a \$14,960 savings to GED test takers

Enabled 17 individuals to acquire their GED

Registered 621 Aspire students in Distance Education classes

Enrolled 914 individuals in the Aspire Program which included 638 students who received twelve or more hours of instruction (325 - Adult Basic Education/Adult Secondary Education and 313 - English for Speakers of Other Languages)

Enrolled 150 English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) students in the on-line language classes offered through Burlington English

Provided Ohio Graduation Test preparation which resulted in the awarding of four (4) high school diplomas
