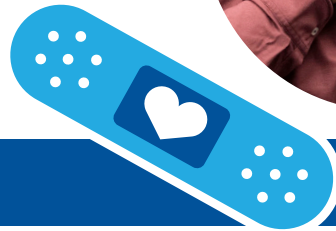

Eligibility

To be eligible for this free COVID-19 vaccine clinic, you need to **be 12 years of age or older.**

Please bring your ID and insurance card with you if you have them. No one will be turned away.

Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson vaccines will be offered. If you choose Pfizer, your second dose appointment will be scheduled when you receive your first dose.
