

Official High School Equivalency Tests

Ohio recognizes the GED and HiSET examinations as being the equivalent of a high school diploma. Like a regular high school diploma, a passing score on any of these tests enables the holder the opportunity to obtain employment, apply for career advancement, pursue higher education goals, or to reach a personal goal.

You must be at least 19 years of age in order to take the GED test.

The fee for the test is \$120. When applying for the test (www.ged.com) you can request a one-time \$80 voucher to lower the cost to \$40.

The Official GED® Test is administered at PearsonVue Testing Centers. All GED® testing is done by appointment only. Appointments are made on-line after completing an on-line registration at www.ged.com.
