Families who do not attend a CCP meeting must arrange a separate CCP counseling session with their school prior to participation in CCP. CCP opportunities at public institutions are free; there may be potential costs at nonpublic institutions. Students and parents must sign **A Letter of Intent to Participate** and return it to the school counselor by April 1, 2020 in order to take CCP classes at colleges or high schools during the 2020-2021 school year, including summer 2020. Forms will be available at all district meetings.
