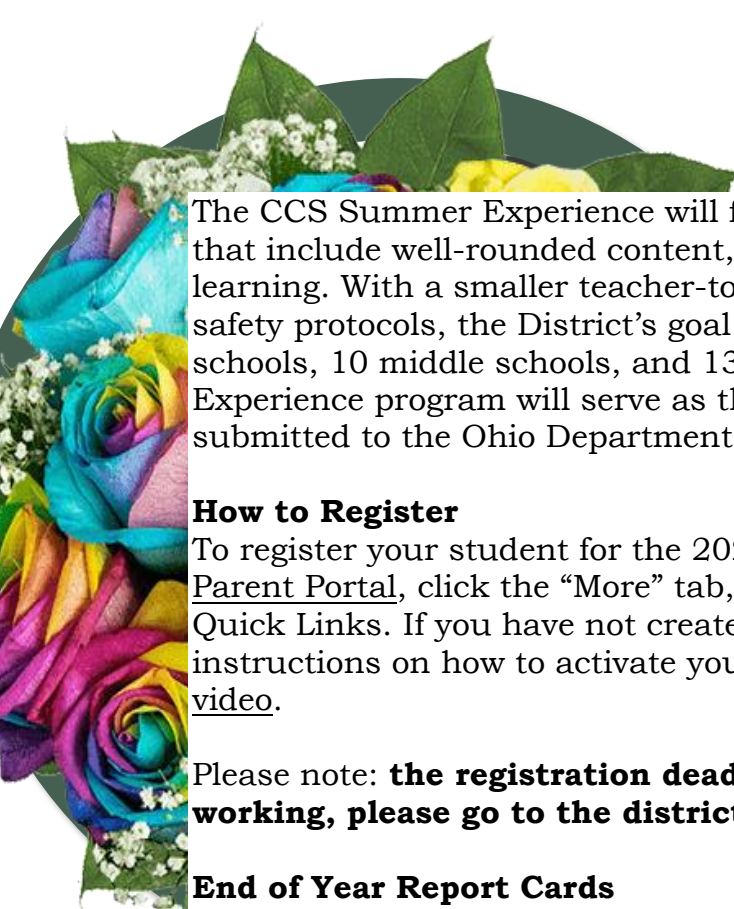

CCS Summer Experience 2021 (Summer School)

Registration is now open for the Columbus City Schools 2021 Summer Experience program.

The Summer Experience program will provide enriching experiences for all students in Pre-K through 12th grade. It is an opportunity for students to accelerate or recover credits. The need for a rich summer experience is critical now more than ever. The District's focus this summer will be on engagement and empowerment for students and educators. Programs run for six weeks beginning on June 14.

CCS is collaborating with a number of community partners to enhance the 2021 Summer Experience program including COSI, the Franklin Park Conservatory, The Ohio State University, and Columbus Department of Recreation and Parks.



The CCS Summer Experience will focus on fundamental knowledge and skills that include well-rounded content, leadership, reasoning, and social-emotional learning. With a smaller teacher-to-student ratio and following all health and safety protocols, the District’s goal is to provide in-person learning at five high schools, 10 middle schools, and 13 elementary schools. The Summer Experience program will serve as the CCS Extended Learning Plan that is submitted to the Ohio Department of Education.

How to Register

Remote Learning Days

Did you know that during remote learning days **your child is responsible to do the following things?**

- Log in to Infinite Campus for attendance
- Complete assigned work that is posted in the Google Classroom
- Meet with teachers on Asynchronous Wednesdays for academic support

It seems as if many students are failing to do any work on remote days. Teachers are spending a great deal of time allowing students opportunities to do work that should have been completed on remote learning days. Unfortunately, we do not have the luxury of spending time ensuring student work is completed. We need your help parents—please check to make certain that your child is completing assigned work and logging in for attendance during remote learning days—**these are not days off of school.**
