5. Under Select Test and Year, Choose "Ohio State Tests," the Administration you want to see, e.g. Spring2018, and the Student Population you want to see, e.g. "Scores for my current students.

When "Student" is selected as the Who at the school level, you will get a list of students. Selecting "Subject" in the What will let you see the performance level; Selecting "Reporting Category" will let you see the scale score, performance level, and reporting category (strand) proficiency. If you select "Item," you will see how the school did on each Item/standard on the test. At the district level, Selecting "Subject," "Reporting Category," or "Items" will give you overall data for the district.
