Reading Inventory

The Reading Inventory (formerly SRI) is a computer-based adaptive test that helps CCS keep track of each student's reading progress. The test is given at the beginning of the year, the middle of the year, and the end of the year in Grades 10-12, if they do not take the MAP. It may also be given for progress monitoring between the MOY, BOY, and EOY. (It is also used in all Read 180 classes Grades 4-12). The test only takes one class period and consists of reading passages and text-dependent questions. The results of the test are reported as a Lexile score. Books are also given Lexile scores. Students and teachers use these Lexile scores to match students and texts. For example, if a student has a Lexile score of 1000, he/she should look for books to read that have a Lexile score in the range of 900-1050 (100 Lexiles below score to 50 Lexiles above). You can find a book's Lexile score by using the "Quick Book Search" at http:// www.Lexile.com or using an App such as "Literacy Leveler" from FikesFarm, LLC. Teachers and students also use the RI results to set goals for reading achievement, provide scaffolding for texts above a student's Lexile score, and develop plans of action for increasing reading proficiency. After each administration, reports can be printed detailing a plan of action for each student. That plan is executed in the classroom and at home to help build a student's reading skills as a way to increase his/her Lexile score. Here are the ranges for current Lexile proficiency at each grade level used by Columbus City Schools/Reading Inventory.
