

Credits Required for Renewing Ohio Credentials

To renew your teaching credentials in the state of Ohio, you must earn 6 semester hours, 9 quarter hours, 18 CEUs, or a combination of these credits after the **ISSUE DATE** of your expiring certificate/license and after the **APPROVAL DATE** of your IPDP.

The following chart explains the equivalents of semester hours, quarter hours and CEUs.

CONVERTING SEMESTER & QUARTER HOURS TO CEUs

| Semester Hours | | Quarter Hours | | CEUs |
|----------------|---|---------------|---|-----------|
| 1 | = | 1.5 | = | 3 |
| 2 | = | 3 | = | 6 |
| 3 | = | 4.5 | = | 9 |
| 4 | = | 6 | = | 12 |
| 5 | = | 7.5 | = | 15 |
| 6 | = | 9 | = | 18 |

← The number of credits required to transition to or renew a license.

1 semester hours is equivalent to 1.5 quarter hours or 3 CEUs.

Note: CEU credits can only be used to renew teaching credentials. They cannot be used to obtain an advanced degree, a continuing contract, or in other instances where college/university credit is required (such as salary increases).
