- Transcript (can be a copy for this deadline date; OSU will require an official transcript, should you ultimately be selected for nomination)

In order to be considered for nomination by Columbus City Schools to the Accelerated Licensure Program, all information must be submitted by the **November 25<sup>th</sup> deadline**, as indicated above. Applicants will be notified in December as to whether or not they have been selected as a Columbus City Schools candidate to be nominated to the program. Please note that because the Accelerated Licensure Program is an OSU program, the final decision regarding actual acceptance into the program for the candidates from the Columbus City Schools will be made by OSU through their own screening and selection process. Also, please note that your application or acceptance into the Accelerated Licensure Program does not obligate you to apply for the CCS Leadership Intern Program, nor guarantee acceptance into the CCS Leadership Intern Program.
