- Leads to Principal Licensure
- Can be completed in four to five semesters
- Designed for currently licensed teachers

Licensure & Endorsement Programs

Ohio Dominican's licensure and endorsement programs are designed to add supplementary credentials to your existing licensure. With options available in a variety of areas and formats, in-classroom curriculum requirements, and coursework that is based on national and/or Ohio standards, ODU's programs will help you achieve your goals as an educator.

Licensure Programs

Intervention Specialist Licensure

- Leads to Ohio Teacher Licensure as an Intervention Specialist in mild to moderate (MM) and/or moderate to intensive (MI) K-12 after passing OAE
- Courses delivered 100% online

Principal Licensure

- Designed for teachers who have completed a M.Ed. in Educational Leadership, but require additional coursework to add the Principal Licensure
- Courses offered online and face to face
- On-campus classes offered 5-8 p.m. once per week
- Can be completed in two semesters

Endorsement Programs

Early Childhood Generalist

- Courses offered 100% online
- Option to complete three courses in any order
- Qualifies you to teach fourth and fifth grades
- May be combined with M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction
- May be completed over the summer or in two semesters

Reading

- Courses offered 100% online
- Five-course series, including phonics
- Transfer credits may be accepted
- May be combined with M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction
- Can be completed in one year

Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL)

- Offered online, with opportunities for face-to-face meetings
- Five-course series
- Courses count toward MA in TESOL or M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction
- Can be completed in one year, including summer

Teacher Leader

- Courses offered online and face to face
- On-campus classes offered 5-8 p.m. once per week
- Master's degree required before endorsement can be applied to license
- Transfer credits may be accepted
- May be completed in two semesters
- May be used to pursue Lead License
- May be combined with M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction
