Please feel free to be creative. At the same time, please keep things simple—we want this to be fun for you and your students, not an additional burden! Don't forget to include your name, grade level/discipline, and school in the video. Email your video to kathy@partnershipsmakeadifference.org.

We plan to select 8–10 videos to share as part of the Summit Zoom, but all recordings contributed will be placed on a special YouTube channel and other social media for teachers and students to view at their convenience.
