Learning Goal

Explore different kinds of shapes.



What You'll Need

- Magazines, newspapers or mail
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick or tape

Steps

- Look for shapes! Look through magazines, newspapers and mail to cut out various shapes. Talk about their characteristics (number of sides, corners, curved, straight).
- 2. Make shapes! You can also use construction paper to make your own shapes.
- **3. Create a shapes collage!** Glue the shapes to a piece of paper to create a shapes collage. Talk with your child about the shapes as you go. Arrange the shapes together to make an animal!
