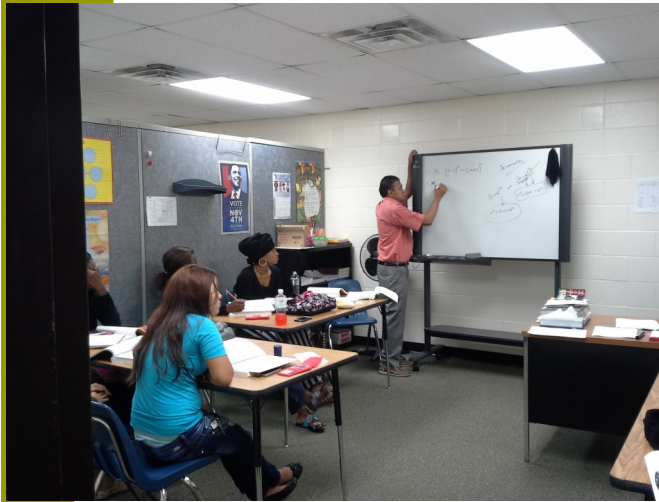

English as a Second Language

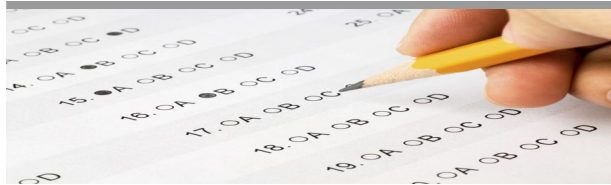


## Who is the OGT, College and Career Readiness Program for?

This program is for ESL students who have passed all of the high school classes needed to graduate but who have not passed all parts of the OGT.

## How will this program help me pass the OGT?

This program consists of in-house tutoring sessions and on-line practice for the OGT, with the primary focus on literacy. Students set up their tutoring time to fit their daily schedule. Volunteers from universities and businesses help provide tutoring.



## What else does this program have to offer me?

Students can also participate in career exploration and basic job skills training including:

- Interview practice
- Résumé building
- Take a career test /explore job options
- Budgeting your money
- Filling out important forms
- Building your communication skills for business
- Improving your reading and writing skills for college and the workforce
- Searching for funding for a technical or college program
- Hear speakers from several different career paths
