To do so, you may send a letter requesting an appeal to the Office of the Treasurer, Columbus City Schools, 270 East State Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. If you request an appeal hearing, you may be represented in such proceedings and may request that any hearing be conducted in private.

You must accompany your student to school for re-enrollment after the expulsion period. You will be required to show address verification to re-enroll your student. Acceptable address verification documents can be found at <u>www.ccsoh.us/Enrollment.aspx</u>. If your student has been transferred to a new school as part of the disciplinary action, you will receive information regarding your student's new school assignment.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding. The District expects your student to follow school regulations and to put forth more effort in academic work upon returning to school.
