REFUSAL OF ASSIGNED ESL SCHOOL

Parents/Guardians of students identified as Limited English Proficient (LEP) have the right to refuse placement in a building with an ESL unit. In order to exercise this right, the parent/guardian must sign this form, which will be placed in the student's permanent file.

Due to <u>Ohio's Third Grade Reading Guarantee Act</u>, parents with kindergarteners or 1st graders who refuse assignment to an ESL school must be aware that, their child/children will have to repeat 3rd grade if they have been in US schools for 3 school years or more and are reading below grade-level. Therefore, we highly recommend that their child be placed in the assigned ESL school. This will help to increase their language and raise their reading level quickly, improving their chances of being at grade-level by the end of 3rd grade.
