Description: Grants of up to \$5,000 to Michigan, Indiana, and Ohio nonprofit organizations for projects, programs, and services that address the dental health needs of adults and children. The Funding Source is particularly interested in initiatives that benefit at-risk populations and promote oral health education.

Full Description:

Funding is intended to support programs designed to: increase access to dental care for at-risk populations, reduce consumption of sugary foods and beverages; educate about and provide oral health care to pregnant women and their babies; and educate about and improve children's oral health, especially in school-based settings.

Estimated Total Program Funding: \$200,000

Estimated Size of Grant: Community Mini-grants are limited to a maximum of \$5,000 per grant.

Term of Contract: Recipients may reapply for funds in future years, as long as there is a grant reporting form on file for the previous grant received.

Eligibility:

- See RFP and/or Grant Guidelines for full eligibility

Additional Eligibility Criteria:

Grants must be dedicated to local not-for-profit programs designed to promote oral health in Michigan, Indiana, and/or Ohio.

Community Mini-grants will not be awarded to/for the following:

- Capital campaigns, salaries, overhead/administrative expenses, endowments, advertising or fundraising activities
- Individuals
- Organizations that discriminate by race, religion, color, creed, gender, age or national origin
- Political organizations or campaigns
- Loans
- Projects developed for commercial or proprietary purposes

Pre-Application Information: Timeline:

- Cycle 1 applications: Open from December 2, 2019 until January 31, 2020, with recipients announced in March.
- Cycle 2 applications: Open from June 1, 2020 until July 31, 2020, with recipients announced in September.

Organizations are able to apply for both cycles, but may only be awarded one grant per calendar year.
