
Description: The Stem Fund is another Spotlight Fund opportunity from Adopt a Classroom and is offered in partnership with Staples, the office supply store.

Snapdragon Book Foundation School Library Grant

Award: Range from \$500 to \$20,000

Description: The Snapdragon Book Foundation provides funds to improve school libraries for disadvantaged children. Founded by a former school librarian, this

foundation exists to put books in the hands of students. In a time when many schools are reallocating their funds to technology and audiovisual equipment, Snapdragon Book Foundation hopes to make sure that school libraries are still offering children good books to read. Grant funding is to be spent on traditional books, processing or cataloguing fees, reference materials for student use, and magazine or newspaper subscriptions. Other media, such as posters, arts and crafts supplies, software,

hardware, or online databases, **are not eligible**. Projects that include significant technology are not likely to be funded unless they express a strong connection to the mission of the organization.

Who Qualifies: Library/Media, Literacy, PreK, Technology Equipment/Devices, Underserved Populations/At Risk

Deadline: Applications are accepted from November I through February 5, 2023

Award: Varies, but the average award is \$10,000
