The purpose of this program is to give children nationwide the opportunity to play high-quality stringed instruments.

Classics for Kids Foundation believes that playing a stringed instrument can transform a child, giving them experiences and skills that can help make them more successful in life. The Foundation offers matching grants for all of the instruments in the string family (including guitars and ukuleles).

Eligible applicants:

- All applicants must have nonprofit status.

- Grants are limited to programs serving children kindergarten through grade 12.

Ineligible applicants:
