Grants to Ohio Students, Groups, and Faculty Mentors for Hands-On STEM Projects

Description: Grants of up to \$5,000 to Ohio undergraduate students, groups, and faculty mentors to support hands-on projects related to STEM, aeronautics, space science and engineering, and earth science. This program supports both group and individual projects. All applications must include a faculty mentor.

Where possible it is highly recommended to include an outreach component that includes the recruitment and participation of female and underrepresented minority university students (i.e., College of Education, Women in Engineering, Society of Black Engineers, etc.), or students attending an Ohio K-12 school in the project. This will assist OSGC to recruit, engage, and retain more females and underrepresented minority students in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics).

Full Description:

Estimated Size of Grant: Total OSGC budget request limited to \$5,000.

Term of Contract: Funding is restricted to one year.

Eligibility:

- See RFP and/or Grant Guidelines for full eligibility

Additional Eligibility Criteria:

All P.I.s, faculty mentors, and students are required to be U.S. citizens.

Pre-Application Information: For SICHOP grants, NASA requires 100% in cost sharing (i.e., 1:1 match). No indirect costs are allowed on requested amounts, but unrecovered or waived indirect costs can help satisfy the cost-share requirement. Indirect costs on direct cost-shared amounts are permitted as well. Cost sharing may include "in-kind" contributions, faculty time, tuition waivers, etc.

Proposals are accepted at any time.
