In addition to whole grade level screening for gifted arts identification and to provide additional opportunities for students to be identified, it is possible to refer a student for individual assessment. To refer a student for gifted identification in the visual and performing arts, please complete the nomination criteria checklist for the arts area to be assessed. Place a checkmark in the box next to each behavior or attribute you have observed in the student. In the space provided, include information you think may be helpful to evaluate the student or attach additional pages. Forward this form to the **Gifted and Talented Office**, **3700 S. High St.**, **Columbus, OH 43207, Attn: GT ARTS IDENTIFICATION**. *Individual Referrals must be received no later than January 24, 2020, for spring assessment*. Any referrals received after January 24, 2020, will need to be resubmitted next year for the fall assessment cycle.

Once the nomination criteria are submitted, a parent "permission to assess" form will be mailed home, and a Renzulli Behavioral Scales Checklist will be mailed to teachers to complete and return. If the student earns a qualifying score for further assessment, he/she will be invited to a performance audition or artwork portfolio evaluation.
