In 2012, the Board of Directors of The Morton Foundation created the Bob Morton Scholarship to be awarded annually to high school graduates accepted to any 4-year higher learning institution. A \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded on a one-time basis based on availability of funds and the applicant's continued meeting of qualifications. The qualifications are a 3.0 GPA or better, previous participation in The First Tee of Central Ohio, and acceptance to any 2 or 4-year higher learning institution. Consideration will be given to volunteerism, community and school activities, financial need and exemplary attitude and character.

4. School and Community Involvement – Description of school and community activities you have participated in.
5. Strength of course of study – What is your GPA? Attach a copy of your official high school transcripts. If you have begun college/university studies, please include your most recent record of grades.
6. Secondary Institution – Indicate the date of proposed entrance to college, field of study in college, name of the college/university (if you are still undecided, please list the colleges you are choosing between), and the expected date of graduation.
7. Career Goals – Explain your specific career objectives and how you feel your involvement with the sport of golf has helped to prepare you to achieve them.
8. Letters of Recommendation – Include two or three letters of reference addressed to The Morton Foundation Scholarship Committee. Job or school reference forms are not accepted. Letters cannot be written by a family member.
