

64 Assignment Changes, 26 Cuts Granted By Board

The Columbus Board of Education approved assignment changes for 64 of its school administrators and a reduction of 26 administrative positions as part of budget cuts for 1977.

The new assignments approved Tuesday become effective Aug. 1. They include replacements for two recently retired directors in the central office, directors for two career centers opening this fall, and principals for two new elementary schools and five new secondary schools.

LUCIEN WRIGHT, who retired after serving the school system for 42 years, will be replaced by Willie J. Anderson, principal at Linden-McKinley High School, as director of human relations.

Martin Russell, currently fine arts supervisor, will replace the retiring Katherine Gill as director of fine and performing arts.

James Jenks and Dennis Grimm, both trades and industry supervisors in the department of practical education, will be the directors of the new career centers. Jenks will move to the northeast center and Grimm to the northwest facility.

TWO ELEMENTARY school principals will move to new elementary schools. Duane Stemen was transferred from Deshler to Northgate, and Reid Jamison will move from Beatty Park to Avalon.

West High School assistant principal James Brannon will become principal of Sherwood Junior High, replacing the retiring W. Dean Trimmer. Thomas Brown, currently the assistant principal of South High School, will become Mifflin Junior High principal.

John Mulherin will move from his principalship at Mohawk Junior-Senior High School to Linden-McKinley principal. Phillip Pool will take over Mulherin's Mohawk position. William Simmons, assistant principal of Whetstone High School, will be the new principal at Barrett Junior High, taking the place of Pool.
