

Public meetings scheduled to discuss school closings

Public meetings will be held during the first two weeks of March to see how the public feels about the plan to close 13 Columbus schools in June.

The meetings will be held at 7 p.m. The first is scheduled for Monday at Marion-Franklin High

School, 1265 Koebel Rd. The proposed closings of Watkins and Forno elementary schools will be discussed at that meeting.

Other meetings, dates and locations:

- Eastmoor High School, 417 S. Weyant Ave., Tuesday to discuss the closing of Berwick Elementary School and then reopening it as an alternative school emphasizing sci-

ence, mathematics and environmental studies.

- Northland High School, 1919 Northcliff Dr., next Wednesday to talk about closing Northgate, Walden and Beaumont elementary schools.
- Whetstone High School, 4405

Scenic Dr., March 4 to discuss closing Kenwood and Duxberry Park elementary schools.

- West High School, 179 S. Powell Ave., March 8 to talk about closing Lindbergh, Chicago Avenue and Garfield Avenue elementary schools.

• Monroe Middle School, 474 N. Monroe Ave., March 9 to discuss closing it and then reopening the school as a traditional alternative school.

- Central High School, 75 S. Washington Blvd., March 10 to talk about closing that school.

Schools propose reassignments

More than 4,000 Columbus Public School students will have to be relocated if the system follows through on a proposal to shut down 13 schools in June.

The 4,145 pupils involved will be given September assignments at other buildings under a plan released Tuesday by school officials.

Central High School students will go to South, East or Briggs high schools.

Also, some Briggs students will go to West, some at West and East will attend Centennial, some at East will be reassigned to Linden-McKinley and some at South will go to Walnut Ridge.

THE NUMBER of students to be reassigned from those other high schools is included in the 4,145 figure, as are the reassignments of elementary school students.

Monroe Middle School students will go to Everett and Ridgeview middle schools.

Beaumont Elementary School students in grades kindergarten through three will go to North Linden Elementary. Fourth- and fifth-graders will go to East Columbus Elementary.

Berwick Elementary students in kindergarten through grade three will attend Scottwood Elementary. Fourth- and fifth-graders will go to Olde Orchard Elementary.

STUDENTS IN Chicago Elementary's western attendance area will be reassigned in accordance with a plan affecting four West Side elementary schools — Trevitt, West Broad, Eastgate and Pilgrim.

Duxberry Park Elementary's closing will create a cluster of elementary schools consisting of Salem, Indian Springs, Colerain and Brentnell. Those schools will pick up some students and retain some grade levels they now have.

Students in the Forno Elementary School area and attending that school will go to Reeb Elementary for grades kindergarten through three. Fourth- and fifth-graders will stay at Moler Elementary.

STUDENTS ATTENDING Forno from the former Heimandale Elementary School will be reassigned to Stockbridge Elementary for kindergarten and grades four and five and to Clarfield Elementary for grades one through three.

The closing of Garfield Elementary will create a school cluster for students from Garfield, Beck, Avondale and Trevitt elementary schools and students from the eastern attendance area of Chicago Elementary.

Winterset and Gladstone elementary schools will take students from Kenwood Elementary and also students in the attendance area of the now-closed Homedale Elementary.

Lindbergh Elementary students will go to either Binns, Ohio or Burroughs elementary schools, depending on grade level.

NORTHGATE ELEMENTARY students will go to Alpine Elementary for grades kindergarten through three. Fourth- and fifth-graders will still attend South Mifflin Elementary.

Walden Elementary students in grades kindergarten through three will go to Avalon Elementary. Arlington Park Elementary will continue to serve fourth- and fifth-graders.

Watkins Elementary area students will go to Clarfield Elementary for grades kindergarten through three. Fourth- and fifth-graders will still attend Stockbridge Elementary.

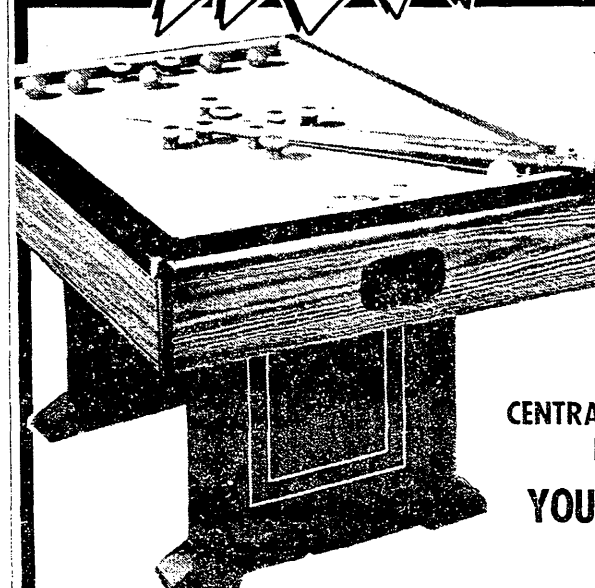
Stockbridge students going to Watkins for grades one through three will go to Clarfield.
