

School district proposes to sell or keep 9 schools

Although discussions continue on what to do with Central High School, Columbus school district officials know what they want to do with some other schools also closed last year.

In recommendations to be acted on at the Columbus school board meeting today, district officials said four of the schools should be sold and five others retained for possible future use as schools.

Proposed for auctioning off are Chicago, Fornoff, Garfield and Walden elementary schools. Suggested for retention are Kenwood, Lindbergh, Northgate, Watkins and Beaumont elementary schools.

Those schools and Central were among 13 closed in June. Three of the schools were later reopened as alternative schools.

The recommendations on the nine schools are contained in the district's annual report on the disposition of closed buildings and vacant sites. The report was released Monday by school Superintendent James G. Hyre.

If the board approves the recommendations, it would bring to 12 the number of schools slated for auction and the number of schools being retained for future

use as schools by the district to 10.

Sixty-two schools have been closed since June 1972 and 16 of them have either been sold or are in the process of being sold. The remaining 24 schools, including Central, are either being leased, used in some other district capacity or sitting idle.

Although the report made no proposal about what to do with Central, Hyre previously has said it could be retained for some kind of educational use if it isn't sold.

However, he has said the school board is not close to making a decision about what to do

with the prime, 16.7-acre Central site downtown.

Frank Maraffa, an assistant school superintendent, said Chicago, Fornoff, Garfield and Watkins are proposed for sale because officials don't consider them good sites for retention. He said they might be attractive properties for potential buyers.

2 killed in one-car crash

Two East Side men were killed Monday night when their car smashed into the steel base of a billboard at Nelson Rd. and E. Livingston Ave., Columbus police said.

Dead are Victor E. Howell,

26, of 1250 E. Livingston Ave., Apt. 4, and his cousin, Richard L. Gray Jr., 32, of 371 Gilbert St.

Police said Howell was driving south on Nelson Rd. about 10:30 p.m. when he failed to make a turn onto Livingston Ave. at the end of Nelson Rd.

Police said the 1972 Chevrolet sped through the intersection at more than 70 mph and crashed into the steel support column of a billboard in a vacant lot on the southern corner of the intersection. Gray, a passenger in the car, died instantly.

Howell was taken to Grant Hospital and died a short time later of multiple injuries.

In another traffic fatality, a

20-year-old Grove City man died early today of injuries he suffered after being struck by a tractor-trailer as he walked on I-71 near Frank Rd. early Monday.

The Circleville post of the State Highway Patrol said Floyd Wray, of 3501 Woodlawn Ave., Grove City, died at 4:33 a.m. at Mt. Carmel West Hospital.

The patrol said Wray was walking in the middle of the southbound lanes of I-71 near Frank Rd. about 2 a.m. Monday when he was struck head-on by a tractor-trailer driven by John Szygal, 39, of Webster, Mass.

Szygal was not injured and no charges were filed, the patrol said.
